## Is This Gift For Me?

### Supplies

6" x 10" light brown fabric scrap (head, ears)

5" x 5" cream fabric scrap (nose, tag)

5" x 5" red fabric scrap (bow)

2" x 2" brown fabric scrap (nose)

Seed beads for eyes

Heat n Bond Lite or other fusible web material

Dark Brown thread for appliqué stitch

11" x 7" fabric rectangle cream/gold

11" x 4 ½" fabric rectangle green



**Directions:** Following the instructions provided by the fusible web manufacturer, trace 1 set of the Wilson pieces grouping together pieces that will be using the same fabric. Cut pieces out.

Follow the pattern placement sheet iron on the face pieces onto the 11" x 7" background rectangle, lining up the bottom edge. Make sure it's centered too. This does not include the bow or tag! Next, sew the green 11" x 4 ½" green rectangle to the bottom edge of the "Is This Gift for Me?" block. Iron. Follow the placement on the pattern, iron on the bow and gift tag.

Using a blanket, zig zag or satin stitch on your sewing machine; sew along the edges of all the pieces. Practice on some scrap material if you are new to machine appliqué. If you prefer hand stitching you can do a blanket stitch using 2 strands of DMC floss. Enjoy!

Use your block for a quilt, placemat or table runner! Have fun!
