

## Tiny Snowman Applique

Fabric scraps in the following colors; White, brown, orange, and red

3 tiny buttons

6 1/2" x 6 1/2" cream fabric block  
DMC floss (black)

Scrap fabric 1" strips to go around mini appliqué block fusible web

### Snowman Directions:

Following the instructions provided by the fusible web manufacturer, trace

1 set of the snowman pieces

grouping together pieces that will be using the same fabric.

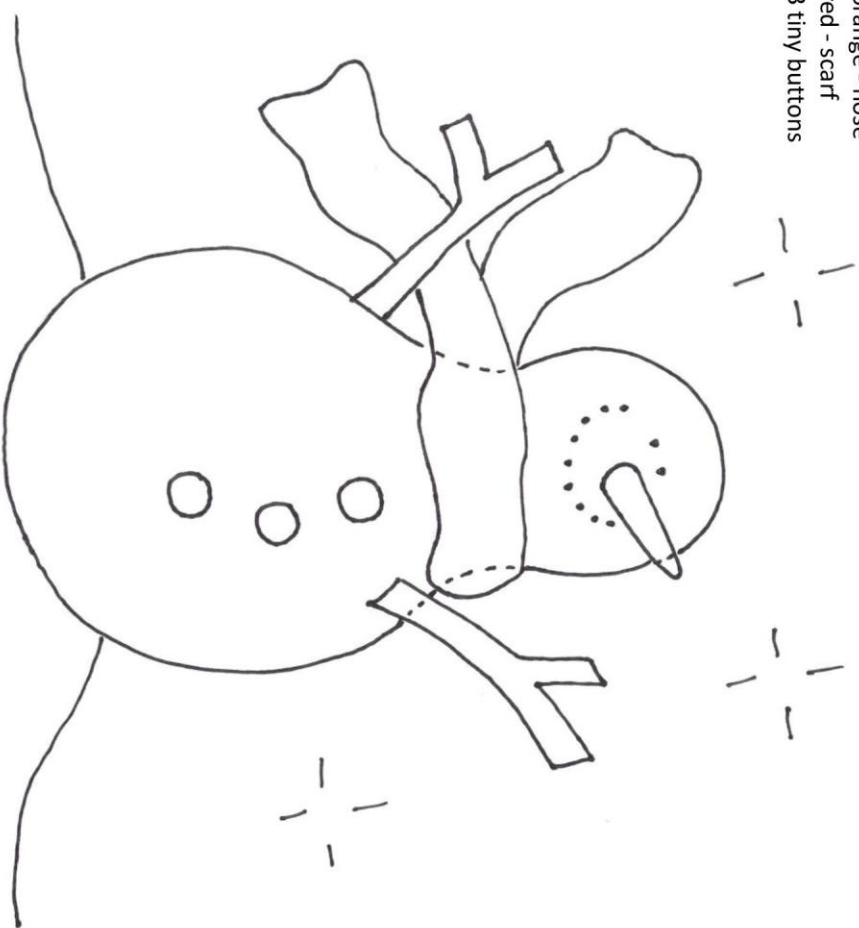
Cut pieces out. Follow the photo of finished quilt square for piece placement. Iron in place. Using a blanket, zig zag or satin stitch on your sewing machine; sew along the edges of all the pieces. Practice on some scrap material if you are new to machine appliqué. If you prefer hand stitching you can do a blanket stitch using 2 strands of DMC floss. .

Referring to the picture sew on the buttons. Using three strands of DMC floss, embroider the 'snow' and 'snowflakes' on the block sewing a backstitch. Using French knots, sew on the snowman's face.

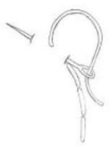

Sew the 1" strips onto the block as desired to make a border. Have fun and add a few rows of borders. Bind for a cute mini quilt or turn it into a sweet little pillow.
