After much soul searching and after checking out our options, I think I have come up with a plan. We will not be closing, like we thought we might have to do, but rather we are moving to the McNaughton building at 608 Carlton Street. It is an old historic stone building, I think a rather nice setting for our quilts. Our last day on Main Street will be September 22 and I will reopen in the new building on October 9.

I am taking this opportunity to restructure the store. I have felt for awhile that I would like to scale back a little (I am now over 65 and not getting younger), but not really ready to call it quits. I am going back to my roots and inviting you to my "Sewing Room", a space where people can come for help, sew, get inspired and meet other like-minded people. There will be machines and tools there if you want to come and get help with a project or just come and hang out with me and quilt! The space is quite a bit smaller than we have had so we are continuing with the sale to decrease the size of the inventory. Although much smaller I hope to carry all the basic supplies you will need, new lines of fabric periodically and do several classes.

One of the big changes will be my hours. I plan on opening Tuesday to Friday from 10:00 - 5:30 and only be open on Saturday if there is a class scheduled. I am hoping this is not too much of an inconvenience.


I am excited to still do what I enjoy the most, researching and trying new products and then sharing that information with you in a class or a demo!

New Mystery from Border Creek starting October 13 at 1:00 p.m.

First Monday of each month starting November 5 9:00-4:00

Did you ever wish you could have some of these precious jewels? Now you can create your own sparkling gem using the single-foundation piecing method. This isn't regular paper piecing! Reusable iron-on templates adhere to the front of the fabric and can be easily removed after piecing.

We will do each of the birthstones, starting with Citrine for Nov. They finish at 17" x 17", so they could be made into pillows or all joined together to make a sparkling quilt!

Right after the long weekend we will welcome you to our new location in the old McNaughton building at 608 Carlton Street. It is pretty easy to find, you keep travelling south up Main St. until you cross the tracks, then you turn east one block. You will see a large stone building on the corner but you need to turn the block and enter on the east side.

What Batting should I use

There are so many types of batting available now so I want to share with you what we carry on a regular basis Heirloom 80/20 Cotton 120" wide \$12.98 per meter

This batting was created by Harriet Hargrave to meet the needs of quilters. It is easy to quilt by hand or machine and can be quilted up to 4 inches apart. It is cotton mixed with 20% polyester, lightly needlepunched and will shrink up to 3%. It can be prewashed if you want to avoid the shrinkage. It has more loft than the typical 100% cotton. Heirloom 80/20 Cotton Black 120" wide \$12.98 per meter

This is the same batting as above only it has been colored black. This is a really good choice when layering a dark quilt. It keeps the saturation of the color.

Washable Wool 96" wide \$24.98 per meter

As a natural fiber, wool is more absorbant than any other fiber. It breathes and acts as a natural insulator, helping to to maintain a comfortable temperature, summer or winter. It can be quilted up to 4 inches apart and has quite a bit moer loft than the cotton.

120" wide \$22.98 Bamboo

Another natural fiber, so it is breathable. This is the softest batting and can be quilted up to 8 inches apart. Polyester Fleece 45" wide \$13.98 per meter

This is a felted polyester batting that we use in placemats, runners and wallhangings that don't need any loft.
