

PROJECT FOR LUMINAIRE/ SOLARIS OR DREAM/DESTINY  
OR 10-NEEDLE WITH DESIGN CENTER

This project is a sampler of different types of embroidery or applique to show you **how to add stippling** to the quilt or project. Hopefully we will cover every situation that you might encounter. You are learning several techniques.

Supplies needed:

9 ½" x 9 ½" hoop or 10 5/8" x 10 5/8" hoop

Fabric and thread:

- 1 yard for front fabric: Neutral or light color and no or minimal design
- 1 yard for back fabric
- 1 yard of batting (batting should be about 4 inches wider on all sides than fabric)
- Threads (Bring several colors) to contrast or show up on your fabric for stippling and light designs and appliques we will do
- Bobbin thread (I use a matching or contrasting thread of the same type as the top thread. For example, if I use embroidery thread as my top thread, I use embroidery thread in the bobbin. If you use Aurifil/Madeira in the top, use the same in the bobbin.

All necessary embroidery supplies: embroidery arm, sewing bobbin case, plastic placement grid for hoop (if using the regular hoops), stylus, FriXion or chalk marker.

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
