Supplies needed:

14" x 9 ½" hoop or 16" x 10 5/8" hoop

I strongly recommend Dime Magnetic hoops

Sewing bobbin case, Embroidery Arm

Bring any quilt you have that you want to try to quilt. If you put together one just  
for this class, follow instructions below:

**Fabric and thread:**

- 1 yard for front fabric (you may use a panel but this class is for edge-to-edge not block-by-block)
- 1 yard or larger for back fabric (size should be slightly larger than front fabric)
- Batting (batting should be about 4 inches wider on all sides than fabric)
- Thread to match fabric for stippling
- Bobbin thread--takes 4 or 5 bobbins or more but that will get you started. (I use a matching or contrasting thread of the same type as the top thread. For example, if I use embroidery thread as my top thread, I use embroidery thread in the bobbin. If you use Aurifil in the top, use the same in the bobbin. Hint: If you use a "busy" fabric as your backing, your bobbin thread looks better. Do not use embroidery bobbin thread which is 60 or 80 wt.)

**Make your quilt sandwich before class. Press creases out of fabric front and back, sandwich the batting in between and pin with quilting safety pins.**

**All necessary embroidery supplies: embroidery arm, plastic placement grid for hoop (if using the regular hoops), pink or blue tape, stylus.**

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
