Embroidering Quilting Borders--RECTANGLE Project

Luminaire (2) /Solaris (2)

January 6 1:00—4:00 following machine training or

This is an <u>embroidery</u> project using the split quilting borders.

You can use the <u>new magnetic border</u> <u>frame</u> or your other magnetic hoops or just the regular $10.5/8 \times 16$ hoop. I strongly recommend a magnetic hoop.

Supplies needed:

- Hoops of your choice
- Quilt sandwich ready to embroidery
- Embroidery or quilting threads to match (contrast with) your fabric and Bobbin thread to match backing



Finished size about 42" x 42"

- \bullet Tear-away stabilizer (20" x 23"). We will use this for practice and measurement sheet.
- Bring your magnifying glass that fits your machine if you have one.

<u>Fabric suggestion for Quilt:</u> Create your quilt before class (see box)

- $\frac{1}{2}$ yd for middle "Quilt" design or a fat quarter Cut 18" x 18"
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yd for border 1 (blue)
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yd for border 2 (yellow)
- 5/8 yd for border 3 (pink)
- 1½ yd for backing (includes extra for hooping)
- 1/3 yd for binding
- 50" x 50" batting

Sew the "quilt" together before class. Make the quilt sandwich before class. Top, batting, backing.

Yardage for blue, yellow, and pink is for 4" borders (Cut $4\frac{1}{2}$ " wide) OR you can make borders any size you want just keep between 2"--- 4". It is ok for them to be different sizes.

Pin or baste with your favorite method. We will start with the border technique and measurements, then stitch.

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
