

REPEAL ORDINANCE 010991

BE IT ADOPTED BY RESOLUTION OF THE KANOSH TOWN COUNCIL, THIS 9TH DAY OF MARCH, 1994 THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION:

WHEREAS, Pursuant to state statutes, Kanosh Town is authorized to adopt local laws relating to the operation and equipment of off-highway vehicle use; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intent of the Town Council to regulate such use within the Town boundaries and to designate roadways which are accessible for use by off-highway vehicle.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF KANOSH TOWN, UTAH:

SECTION 1. All operators of off-highway vehicles shall be duly licensed to operate such vehicles in accordance with state laws, rules and regulations, including the obtaining of a safety certificate issued by the Division of Parks and Recreation, as applicable.

SECTION 2. All operators of off-highway vehicles who are ages eight (8) through thirteen (13), inclusive, shall be accompanied while operating such vehicle within City limits by an adult on an accompanying licensed all terrain Type I or II vehicle, motorcycle or snowmobile (as defined by state statute). All operators of off-highway vehicles who are fourteen (14) or fifteen (15) years of age do not need to be accompanied by an adult.

SECTION 3. Off-highway vehicles shall be used and operated only on or over such public lands, trails, streets, roads or highways within Kanosh that area designated by this resolution as open to such vehicles use, and all such designated accessways shall be posted by signs to evidence their off-highway vehicles shall be operated only on the outer four feet (4') of the asphalt on oiled roadways or of unimproved gravel or dirt roads within Kanosh Town limits.

SECTION 4. Off-highway vehicles shall be operated at all times in accordance with all applicable state, county and town laws and regulations, and shall not be operated at speeds in excess of ten (10) miles per hour on Kanosh town roadways, and, further, if equipped with a headlight, shall be operated only with the headlights functioning and turned on.

SECTION 5. The following-described roadways are hereby designated as open to off-vehicle use in conformance with all applicable laws, resolutions, and regulations of Kanosh Town and the State of Utah:

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING SPECIFIED STREETS WITHIN KANOSH TOWN LIMITS AS APPROVED  
FOR USE OF OFF HIGHWAY VEHICLES.

BE IT ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE OF THE KANOSH TOWN BOARD THAT THE FOLLOWING STREETS  
BE DESIGNATED FOR USE BY OFF HIGHWAY VEHICLES.

ALL STREETS WITHIN THE KANOSH TOWN LIMITS  
WITH THE FOLLOWING RULES ESTABLISHED TO GOVERN SAID USE.

1. Speed limit for all operators of OHV's 10 mph
2. All riders between 8 & 16 years of age must meet State certification requirements (and training) and be accompanied or supervised by a parent or guardian on a similar type OHV, within 50 feet at all times. The parent or guardian must be proficient in the operation of both vehicles.
