Learn the nuts and bolts of collage quilting utilizing Laura Heine's latest techniques. Choose from any Laura Heine collage pattern while enjoying the Creative Passions Retreat Center in Chesaning Michigan. No class prep work is needed as I like teach you the latest techniques from start to finish. These quilts are doable and fun for all levels of quilters. If you are not a fan of binding I will demo a no binding technique. Are you still nervous about sandwiching and quilting your own projects, I will demo a no sew finishing technique.



- I will have a trunk show and pop up shop set up in the classroom with all necessary supplies and kits available to purchase. You may purchase your supplies/pattern ahead of time or just show up and browse my pop up shop. Additionally I will have loaner fuse mats and collage scissors if you are not certain you will ever use them again, just borrow mine during class. Creative Passions Quilt Shop is also just down the road with so many fat-quarters, you'll surely find something you need!!
- Creative Passions Retreat Center will be our host and will be providing all meals (yeah, no cooking). Rooms are attached to the classroom space, so no need to get out of your pajamas in this judgement free space. Checkin on Fri Aug 8 at noon and checkout by 3 pm on Sun Aug 10. Total cost is \$325 for Room, Board, and teaching Fees. If you would like to come for the day only the cost is \$100 for food and teaching fees.



Supply List (Must Haves for class):

(All supplies will be available for purchase in a pop up shop at the retreat so you can literally just show up)

- Laura Heine Collage Pattern of your choice
- Kit or fabrics from your stash
- 17" by 24" silicone fuse mat and pressing sheet
- Mechanical pencil
- Collage Foundation (Pattern Ease)
- Steam a Seam 2 by the yard, amount needed will vary by project (please no steam a seam 2 lite)
- o Karen K Buckley Medium Perfect Scissors (micro serrated) or Laura Heine's Collage Scissors
- Small Rotary Cutter, Mat, and Ruler (I will bring a large mat and rulers)
- Sewing machine is NOT needed unless you are a fast worker or need help finishing up a previous collage project
- o Irons and ironing boards are available in class but you may wish to bring your own small iron setup for your workspace
- If you would like a particular Kit or need help with choosing fabric from your stash reach out to me

I live in Plymouth, MI and work as an Nurse Anesthetist. I made my first collage quilt in the spring of 2020 and have since made too many collage quilts to count. Over the past 5 years, I have traveled to take classes from Laura Heine 4 times. I love to teach Laura Heine's collage techniques and demonstrating that it is doable and fun for all levels of quilters.
