Twin Quilt: 59" x 82 1/2"

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips. PLEASE NOTE:

Cut all 7-1/4" squares in half diagonally twice for the number of triangles indicated in [].

Cut all 3-7/8" squares in half diagonally for the number of triangles indicated in [].

Fabric A - Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, somewhat fussy cut (5) 6-1/2" squares

Fabric B - Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric C - Cut (2) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (20) 3-7/8" squares [40] Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (1) 7-1/4" strip, subcut (5) 7-1/4" squares [X] [20] Cut (2) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 6-1/2" squares and (10) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 3-7/8" squares [16] Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric E - Cut (1) 7-1/4" strip, subcut (5) 7-1/4" squares X [20] Cut (5) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (46) 3-7/8" squares / [92]

Fabric F - Cut (3) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (24) 3-7/8" squares [/ [48] Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric G - Cut (2) 7-1/4" strips, subcut (6) 7-1/4" squares [X] [24] and (2) 3-7/8" squares [4]

Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces

Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (10) 3-7/8" squares [20]

Fabric H - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 3" x 66-1/2" ornament borders and (2) 8-3/4" x 59-1/2" multi-stripe borders [1 with ornaments on top and 1 with ornaments on bottom]


2. Piecing Order:


 Sew 1 each Fabrics E and F 3-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 48 Unit 1 (3-1/2" square unfinished).



Arrange 2 Unit 1 and 2 Fabric B 3-1/2" squares in 2 rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 6 each Units 2a-2d (6-1/2" square unfinished).









Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

- Arrange 2 each Fabrics C and F 3-1/2" squares in 2 rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 24 Unit 3 (6-1/2" square unfinished).

4. Sew **Fabrics E** 3-7/8" triangles to short edges of a Fabric G 7-1/4" triangle. Make a total of 12 Unit 4a (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 4b-4f listed with fabrics indicated.

Stitch a Fabric G 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece to a Unit 4a as shown. Make a total of 12 Unit 5a (6-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 5b-5d listed with 1 unit and (1) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece or 2 units as shown.


- 11. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 12. Arrange blocks in 5 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (54-1/2" x 66-1/2" unfinished).
- 13. Sew **Fabric H** 3" x 66-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric H** 8-3/4" x 59-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 14. The quilt measures approximately 59-1/2" x 83" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 15. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!



1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips. PLEASE NOTE:

Cut all 7-1/4" squares in half diagonally twice for the number of triangles indicated in [].

Cut all 3-7/8" squares in half diagonally for the number of triangles indicated in [].

Fabric A - Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, somewhat fussy cut (5) 6-1/2" squares

Fabric B - Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric C - Cut (2) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (20) 3-7/8" squares [/ [40] Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (1) 7-1/4" strip, subcut (5) 7-1/4" squares X [20] Cut (2) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 6-1/2" squares and (10) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 3-7/8" squares [16] Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric E - Cut (1) 7-1/4" strip, subcut (5) 7-1/4" squares X [20] Cut (5) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (46) 3-7/8" squares [/ [92]

Fabric F - Cut (3) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (24) 3-7/8" squares [/ [48] Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric G - Cut (2) 7-1/4" strips, subcut (6) 7-1/4" squares [X] [24] and (2) 3-7/8" squares [/ [4]

Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces

Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (10) 3-7/8" squares [20]

2. Piecing Order:

 Sew 1 each Fabrics E and F 3-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 48 Unit 1 (3-1/2" square unfinished).

2. Arrange 2 Unit 1 and 2 Fabric B 3-1/2" squares in 2 rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 24 Unit 2 (6-1/2" square unfinished).

Arrange 2 each Fabrics C and F 3-1/2" squares in 2 rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 24 Unit 3 (6-1/2" square unfinished).

4. Sew Fabrics E 3-7/8" triangles to short edges of a Fabric G 7-1/4" triangle. Make a total of 12 Unit 4a (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make the number



of Units 4b-4f listed with fabrics indicated.

5. Stitch a **Fabric G** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece to a Unit 4a as shown. Make a total of 12 Unit 5a (6-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 5b-5d listed with 1 unit and (1) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece or 2 units as shown.





6. Arrange 1 Fabric A 6-1/2" square, 2 each Units 5a and 5b, and 4 Unit 2 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 5 Block 1 (18-1/2" square unfinished).

7. Arrange 1 Fabric D 6-1/2" square, 2 each Units 5c and 5d, and 4 Unit 3 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Block 2 (18-1/2" square unfinished).


8. Sew a Unit 5c between 2 Unit 3 as shown. Make a total of 4 Block 3




total of 2 Block 4 (6-1/2" x 18-1/2" unfinished).

- 10. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 11. Arrange blocks in 5 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together.
- 12. The quilt measures approximately 54-1/2" x 66-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric H) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 13. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric D) and enjoy!!



BASIC Panel Quilt #9 featuring The Toy of Giving

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following for Wall Quilt:

Refer to thumbnails on pattern cover for Fabrics A-E used in this design.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 22-1/2" x 41-1/2"


Fabric B - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding) Cut (4) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 26" borders

Fabric C - Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (1) 3" x 21" strip Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips


Fabric D - Cut (4) 3" strips Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 21" strips

2. Piecing Order for Wall Quilt:

- 1. Stitch 2 **Fabric C** 2-1/2" x width of fabric strips together end to end. Make a total of 4.
- 2. Stitch 2 **Fabric D** 3"x width of fabric strips together end to end. Make a total of 2.
- 3. Sew a double-length **Fabric D** 3" strip between 2 **Fabric C** 2-1/2" double-length strips. Make a second strip set. Subcut each into (1) 7" x 43-1/2" border, (1) 7" x 24-1/2" border, and (2) 3" x 7" Unit 1.



4. Sew a **Fabric C** 3" x 21" strip lengthwise between 2 **Fabric D** 2-1/2" x 21" strips. Subcut into (8) 2-1/2" x 7" Unit 2.



5. Sew a Unit 1 between 2 Unit 2. Make a total of 4 blocks (7" square unfinished).



- Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of panel, borders, and blocks
- 7. Stitch **Fabric B** 2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2" x 26" **Fabric B** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to* 24-1/2" x 43-1/2" (unfinished).
- 8. Stitch **Fabrics C** and **D** 7" x 43-1/2" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Sew blocks to short ends of **Fabrics C** and **D** 7" x 24-1/2" borders then add to top and bottom of quilt.
- 9. The quilt measures approximately 37-1/2" x 56-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric E**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 10. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric B) and enjoy!!
