

## Star Crossed Paths

Featuring Field of Dreams
Quilt size: 72" x 72", Finished Block size: 12"
MATERIALS
4 yards Cream Garden Scroll 8935M-07 for blocks
7/8 yard Dark Sage Shadow Blush 2045-42 for blocks
$13 / 4$ yards Black Butterfly Garden 8934M-12 for blocks and binding
1 yard Midnight Blue Botanical Leaves $8937-55$ for blocks
$47 / 8$ yards Backing
80" x 80" batting
Yardages are based on 42" usable fabric width. Cutting sizes include $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.

## Cut

(28) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares
(24) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8$ " squares
(16) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, cut in half diagonally to form 32 triangles
(64) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
(64) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
(24) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
(24) $47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares

12 strips $13 / 4$ " $x$ width of fabric (WOF)
(24) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8$ " squares
(8) $67 / 8$ " $\times 67 / 8$ " squares, cut in half diagonally to form 32 triangles
8 strips 2 1/2" x WOF for binding
(4) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
(16) squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

12 strips $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} x$ width of fabric (WOF)

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of cream $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. With right sides together, layer a cream and sage $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line. Open and press toward the sage fabric
 to form 48 half-square triangles ( $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, finished size $3^{\prime \prime}$ ).
2. Sew 4 beige $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, 4 beige $37 / 8$ " triangles, 2 black $67 / 8$ " triangles and 6 trian-gle-squares together as shown to form the block sections. Sew the sections together. Repeat to make 4 blocks.

3. In the same way, sew 3 beige 3 1/2" squares, 1 midnight 3 1/2" square, 4 beige 3 7/8" triangles, 2 black $67 / 8$ " triangles and 6 triangle-squares together as shown below to make 4 blocks.

4. Sew a midnight and cream strip together to make a strip set. Make 12. Cut the strips sets at $13 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ increments to make 256 segments. Sew 2 segments together to make a Four Patch. Make 128 total.

5. Sew 4 cream 3" x 7 1/2" rectangles, 4 cream 2 1/2" x 3" rectangles, 1 midnight 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square and 8 Four Patches together to make a block as shown below. Repeat to make 16 blocks.

6. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of cream $47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. With right sides together, layer a cream and sage $47 / 8 " \times 47 / 8 "$ square. Sew $1 / 4$ " on both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line. Open and press toward the sage
 fabric to form 48 half-square triangles (41/2", 4" finished).
7. Sew 2 cream 4 1/2" squares, 3 black 4 1/2" squares and 4 triangle-squares together to make a block as shown below. Make 12 blocks.

8. Arrange the blocks in 6 rows as shown. Sew the blocks into rows. Sew the rows together.

9. Layer and baste the backing, batting and quilt top.
10. Quilt as desired. Bind the quilt with butterfy garden.
