

Middleboro Road Quilt


Finished quilt size: 76 1/2" x 76 1/2"

Finished block size: 7 1/2" x 7 1/2"

Backing: 84" x 84" (4 3/4y of 42" wide fabric, or 2 3/8y of 108" wide fabric)

Binding: 5/8y of R581563D Sky, cut (9) 2 1/4" x WOF strips, pieced to make a binding strip

Fabric and cutting chart

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting directions
 Fabric A R581558D Navy	3/4y	a. Outer border (8) 3" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3" x 72" and (2) 3" x 77" strips.
 Fabric B R581560D Blue	3/8y	a. 25-patch blocks (from each fabric) (4) 2" x WOF strips. Reserve for strip piecing.

 Fabric E R581561D Yellow	5/8y	a. 25-patch blocks (2) 2" x WOF strips. Reserve for strip piecing. b. Star blocks (8) 2" x WOF strips. Reserve for strip piecing. (1) 2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 2" x 2" squares.

 Fabric G R581564D Yellow	7/8y	a. Star blocks (2) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 2" x 2" squares. (7) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (82) 3" x 3" and (1) 2" x 2" squares.
 Fabric I R581566D Cream	4 1/2y	a. 25-patch blocks (24) 2" x WOF strips. Reserve for strip piecing. b. Star blocks (19) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut (164) 2" x 2" squares and (84) 2" x 5" rectangles. (7) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (82) 3" x 3" squares. (4) 5" x WOF strips. Reserve for strip piecing. c. Inner border (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 68" and (2) 2 1/2" x 72" strips.

Constructing 25-patch blocks

1. Sew together, along the long sides, WOF strips for the following fabrics, to make a strip set: J, I, D, I, F. Make a total of (2) strip sets, and subcut (40) units at 2" intervals.



2. Sew together, along the long sides, WOF strips for the following fabrics, to make a strip set: I, B, I, H, I. Make a total of (2) strip sets, and subcut (40) units at 2" intervals.



3. Sew together, along the long sides, WOF strips for the following fabrics, to make a strip set: C, I, E, I, C. Make a total of (2) strip sets, and subcut (40) units at 2" intervals.



4. Sew together, along the long sides, WOF strips for the following fabrics, to make a strip set: I, H, I, D, I. Make a total of (2) strip sets, and subcut (40) units at 2" intervals.



5. Sew together, along the long sides, WOF strips for the following fabrics, to make a strip set: F, I, B, I, J. Make a total of (2) strip sets, and subcut (40) units at 2" intervals.



6. Sew together step 1-5 units to complete (1) 25-patch block. Block measures 8" x 8" unfinished. Make a total of (40) blocks.



Constructing star blocks


1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" x 3" Fabric I square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 3" x 3" Fabric G square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to make (2) HST units. Open and press.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) HST unit, crossing both fabrics. Place unit, right sides together, on another HST unit, with contrasting fabrics facing each other. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to make (2) QST units. Open and press. Square and trim unit to measure 2" x 2" unfinished, with the center of unit at 1" mark on a quilting ruler.




Make a total of (4) units.

2. Sew (2) 2" x 2" Fabric I squares to the opposite sides of (1) step 1 unit to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units. Sew (2) step 1 units to the opposite sides of (1) 2" x 2" Fabric G square to make a row unit. Sew together row units to complete (1) star unit. Unit measures 5" x 5" unfinished.




3. Sew (2) 2" x 5" Fabric I (correction: 10/12/25) rectangles to the opposite sides of step 2 unit to make a row unit.



4. Sew (2) 2" x WOF Fabric E strips to the opposite long sides of (1) 5" x WOF Fabric I strip to make a strip set. Make a total of (4) strip sets. Subcut (40) units at 2" intervals. [Note: A total of (42) units are needed for the star blocks. (2) more units are needed for the 41st star blocks. Instead of strip piecing, sew (2) 2" x 2" Fabric E squares to the opposite sides of (1) 2" x 5" Fabric I rectangle to make (1) unit. Repeat to make the second unit.]



5. Sew (2) step 4 units to the top and bottom of step 3 unit to complete (1) star block. Block measures 8" x 8" unfinished.



Make a total of (41) blocks.

Quilt top assembly


Note: Border strips are sewn shorter strips first to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by longer strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.

1. Pieced row. Arrange and sew together (9) pieced blocks to make a pieced row. Make a total of (9) pieced rows.

Rows 1, 3, 5, 7, 9: (5) star and (4) 25-patch blocks


Rows 2, 4, 6, 8: (4) star and (5) 25-patch blocks

2. Quilt center. Sew together pieced rows to complete quilt center.



3. Inner border. Fabric I. (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 68" strips, then (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 72" strips.

4. Outer border. Fabric A. (2) 3" x 72" strips, then (2) 3" x 77" strips to complete quilt top.



Finishing

1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.

2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.

3. Bind to complete the quilt.
