Approx. 82" x 82"

Marcus Fabrics Franklin House Quilt






Finished quilt size: 82" x 82"

Finished block size: 14" x 14"





Backing: 90" x 90" (5y of 42" wide fabric, or 2 1/2y of 108" wide fabric)

Binding: 3/4y of R541540D, cut into (10) 2 1/4" x WOF strips, and pieced to make a binding strip.

 Fabric B R541538D Blue	1/2y	a. B blocks (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.
 Fabric C R541539D Blue	1 1/3y	a. B Blocks (1) 3" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 3" x 3" and (3) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (12) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. b. Outer border (8) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3 1/2" x 76 1/2" and (2) 3 1/2" x 82 1/2" strips.
 Fabric D R541541D Navy	1/4y	a. B Blocks (1) 3" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 3" x 3" squares. (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.
 Fabric E 541542 D Navy	3/8y	a. B Blocks (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (12) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles and (3) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

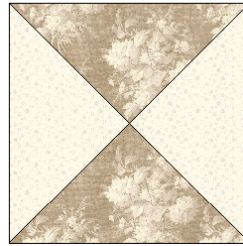

 <p>Fabric G R541544D Cream</p>	3 7/8y	<p>a. A Blocks (3) 15 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (8) 15 1/2" x 15 1/2" squares. Subcut from leftover (24) 2" x 6 1/2" rectangles to be used in B Blocks. b. B Blocks (13) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (208) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. (2) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (26) 3" x 3" squares. (2) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (28) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. c. Inner border (8) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3 1/2" x 70 1/2" and (2) 3 1/2" x 76 1/2" strips.</p>

 <p>Fabric I R541546D Sky</p>	1/4y	<p>a. B Blocks (1) 3" x WOF strip. Subcut (8) 3" x 3" squares. (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (16) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.</p>

### Constructing A Blocks

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1)  $15\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square. Place square, right sides together, on (1)  $15\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press.

2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) HST unit, crossing the opposite seam line. Place unit, right sides together, on another HST unit with contrasting fabrics facing each other. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) QST units. Open and press. Trim and square units to measure  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished, with the center of unit at  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " on quilting ruler.



Make a total of (12) blocks.

## Constructing B Blocks

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" x 3" Fabric G square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 3" x 3" Fabric I square. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Align diagonal seam of units with the 45 degree line on quilting ruler, trim units to measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



Make a total of (4) units.

2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square. Place square, right sides together, at the bottom left of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle.



Make a total of (4) units.

3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square. Place square, right sides together, at the top left corner of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle.



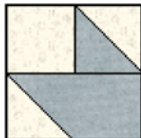
Make a total of (4) units.

4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square. Place square, right sides together, at the top left corner of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle.

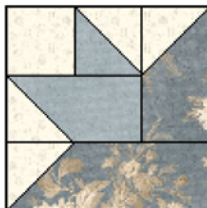


Make a total of (4) units.

5. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square to the left of (1) step 1 unit. Add (1) step 2 unit to the bottom of the combined unit.



6. Sew (1) step 3 unit to the right of step 5 unit, followed by (1) step 4 unit to the bottom. Unit measures  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



Make a total of (4) units.

7. Sew (2) step 6 units to the opposite long sides of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G rectangle to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units. Sew (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G rectangles to the opposite sides of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square to make a row unit. Sew together row units to complete (1) B Block. Block measures  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make a total of (4) blocks.



Repeat to make (3) blocks for the following fabric combinations:

H/C	C/E	D/F

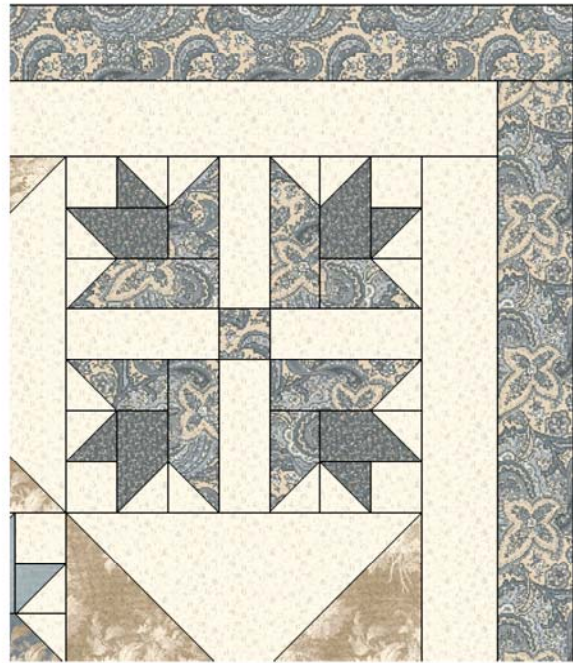
### Quilt top assembly

Note: Border strips are sewn shorter strips first to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by longer strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.

1. Pieced rows. Refer to quilt image for block placement, arrange and sew together (5) pieced blocks to make a pieced row. Make a total of (5) pieced rows.
2. Quilt center. Sew together pieced rows to complete quilt center.



3. Inner border. Fabric G.  
(2) 3 1/2" x 70 1/2" strips, then (2) 3 1/2" x 76 1/2" strips.
4. Outer border. Fabric C.  
(2) 3 1/2" x 76 1/2" strips, then (2) 3 1/2" x 82 1/2" strips to complete quilt top.



### Finishing

1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to complete the quilt.
