

Fabric A 5/8 yard
Fabric B 3/4 yard
Fabric C 1/2 yard
Fabric D 5/8 yard
Fabric E 1/2 yard
Fabric F 1/2 yard
Fabric G 1/2 yard

Fabric H 1/2 yard
Fabric I 1/3 yard
Fabric J 5/8 yard
Fabric K 5/8 yard (Binding Only)
Fabric L 3-1/2 yards (44/45" Backing Only)

Quilt Size: 53" x 65"

BASIC Medium Throw Quilt #13

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Cut (2) 6-7/8" strips, subcut (10) 6-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 20 triangles] and (4) 3-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric B - Cut (3) 6-7/8" strips, subcut (14) 6-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 28 triangles

Fabric C - Cut (1) 6-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 6-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 8 triangles

Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (2) 6-7/8" strips, subcut (12) 6-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 24 triangles

Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (2) 6-7/8" strips, subcut (12) 6-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 24 triangles

Fabrics F and G - From each fabric:

Cut (2) 6-7/8" strips, subcut (8) 6-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 16 triangles

Fabric H - Cut (1) 6-7/8" strip, subcut (6) 6-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 12 triangles

Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (16) 3-1/2" squares


Fabric I - Cut (1) 6-7/8" strip, subcut (6) 6-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 12 triangles

Fabric J - Cut (6) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 60-1/2" and (2) 3" x 53-1/2" borders

Fabric K - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)


2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch **Fabrics A** and **B** 6-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 4 **Block 1a** (6-1/2" square unfinished).




Block 1a - Make 4


2. In the same manner, make the following number of blocks and units indicated:




Block 1b - Make 12




Block 1c - Make 16




Block 1d - Make 12

Unit 2a - Make 8





Unit 2b - Make 16


3. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of each of the **Fabrics A, C, D, and H** 3-1/2" squares.



4. Arrange marked **Fabrics C** and **D** 3-1/2" squares on a Unit 2a as shown. Stitch across marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make a total of 8 **Block 2a** (6-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 16 **Block 2b** with Unit 2b and **Fabrics A** and **H** 3-1/2" squares.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

5. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of blocks and border.

6. Arrange blocks in 10 rows. Stitch blocks into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center 48-1/2" x 60-1/2" (unfinished).

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7. Stitch **Fabric J** 3" x 60-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric J** 3" x 53-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

8. The quilt measures approximately 53-1/2" x 65-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric L**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

9. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric K**) and enjoy!!

QUILT LAYOUT

Border measurements are the cut size.

Shading of Quilt Layout may vary depending on fabrics used.
