KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A	Centering design, fussy-cut: (6) 5"squares on point using template.
В	(2) 4-1/4" x WOF 42" strips and (1) 4-1/4" x 10" rectangle; sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 4-1/4" x 45-1/2" borders. (4) 28" x 4-1/4" LOF strips; sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 52-1/2" x 4-1/4" borders.
С	(2) 5" squares.
D	(4) 4-1/8" squares; cut squares in half diagonally once to make (8) triangles.
Е	Centering design, fussy-cut: (24) 5" squares using template.
F	Centering design, fussy-cut: (8) 5-1/2" right triangles using template.
G	(6) 1-3/4" x 42" strips; subcut (24) 1-3/4" x 9-1/2" strips. (5) 1-1/2" x 42" strips; sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" borders and (2) 1-1/2" x 38" borders.
н	(1) 7-5/8" x 42" strip; subcut (3) 7-5/8" squares and (2) 7-1/4" squares. Cut 7-1/4" squares in half diagonally once to make (4) triangles. Cut 7-5/8" squares in half twice to make (12) triangles.
I	Centering design, fussy-cut: (8) 2-3/4" x 25" LOF strips; sew short ends together matching the print. Subcut (2) 2-3/4" x 51-1/2" borders and (2) 2-3/4" x 37" borders.
J	(4) 1-1/2" x 42" strips, sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 44" borders and (2) 1-1/2" x 31-1/2" borders.
K	(1) 2-3/8" x 42" strip; subcut (5) 2-3/8" squares and (7) 2" squares. Cut 2-3/8" squares in half diagonally once to make (10) triangles.
L	FOR BINDING: (6) 1-1/2" x 42" strips, sew short ends together.




#### **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

3-1/4" backing fabric Sewing machine Rotary cutter, ruler and mat 54" x 68" batting
Thread to match fabrics
Basic sewing supplies

**Optional:** Lightweight fusible interfacing

#### **CUTTING**

**1.** Make see through plastic templates for (1) 5" square and (1) 5-1/2" right triangle. If desired, mark the seam allowance 1/4" from the edge for placing the fabric motifs within the template.



**2.** Place the 5" template on fabric **E** as shown. Trace a portion of the motifs shown onto the template using a pencil so you can line it up each additional square on the fabric. Trace around the template using a marking pen. Trace sets of squares featuring (4) different motifs as indicated or as desired. Erase pencil lines when one set of motifs is complete and trace placement lines for next set of squares. Trace all (24) 5" squares onto the fabric before cutting.


- **3.** Trace the 5" square on fabric **A** on point centering the motifs of the children. Make (6) featuring different children as shown on the Quilt Layout or as desired.
- **4.** Trace the 5-1/2" triangles centered over the motifs on fabric **F** placing the long edges along the straight grain. Note the orientation of the fabric on the triangles as shown in the Quilt Layout.
- **5.** If desired, cut 1/4" wide strips of lightweight fusible interfacing and fuse to the wrong side of the fabric to stabilize the bias edges of **A** and **E** 5" squares and **F** 5-1/2" triangles.








#### **BLOCKS**

- 6. Sew (2) E 5" squares together in pairs noting the orientation of the squares. Make 2.
- 7. Sew the pairs together matching the center seam to complete Block 1. Make the number indicated of each fabric **E** combination.

- **8.** Sew (4) **D** 4-1/4" triangles to the sides of (1) C 5" square to make a C/D unit.
- **9.** Sew (4) **F** 5-1/2" triangles to the sides of (9) **C/D** unit to make Block 2. Make 2.



#### **TRIANGLES**

10. Following the Quilt Layout on page 6, sew (2) H triangles to adjacent edges of (1) A 5" square. Note orientation of fabric  ${\bf A}$  so the motifs appear upright when assembling the quilt. Make the number of triangles indicated.

#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

- **11.** Following the quilt layout on page 6, arrange (6) Block 1, (2) Block 2, (6) Triangles and (4) Corner Triangles in diagonal rows. Place  $\mathbf{G}$  1-3/4" x 9-1/2" strips between the blocks and triangles. Sew the Blocks, Triangles and Strips in each row together.
- **12**. Arrange **G** 1-3/4"  $\times$  9-1/2" strips, **K** 2-3/8" triangles and **K** 1-3/4" squares to make the sashing rows. Sew the ends together noting the orientation of the triangles.
- **13.** Sew the Block/Triangle rows and sashing rows together matching the seams. Quilt center should measure 29-1/2" x 44" including seam allowance.
- **14.** Sew (1) **J** 1-1/2"  $\times$  44" border to each side of the quilt. Sew (2) **J** 1-1/2"  $\times$  31-1/2" borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- **15.** Trim the ends of (4) I borders diagonally. Sew the short sides of (1) I 2-3/4" x 51-1/2" border to each side of the quilt beginning and ending stitching 1/4" from the ends of the seam. Sew the short sides of (2) I 2-3/4" x 37-1/2" borders to the top and bottom of the quilt in the same way. Sew the diagonal ends of the adjacent borders together.
- **16.** Sew (1) **G** 1-1/2"  $\times$  50-1/2" border to each side of the quilt. Sew (2) **G** 1-1/2"  $\times$  38" borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- **17.** Sew (1) **B** 52-1/2"  $\times$  4-1/4" border to each side of the quilt. Sew (2) **B** 4-1/4"  $\times$  45-1/2" borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.

**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using six fabric **L** 2-1/4" strips.
