FUSIBLE WEB - ARE THEY ALL THE SAME?

Fusible Applique allows you to create shapes you never could with piecing - lots of intricate curves are easy to create with applique. If you've never done fusible applique, let me break down the process for you:

- Trace your design on the paper side of fusible web
- Iron the glue side onto the back of your fabric
- Cut on the line you drew to create your final applique shape
- Peel off the paper and place glue side down onto your background fabric
- Iron to adhere the shape

Sounds easy, right? With a variety of fusible webs on the market, the most difficult part can be choosing the right one. Let me break down the pros and cons of some of the top selling brands.

Some fusible webs are thick and make your quilt feel more like a board. Others are lightweight and add no bulk. SoftFuse is one of the lightweight fusible webs. It's durable and provides great adherence, but it's light weight so you'll hardly know there is a fusible web on your quilt. Because it's so lightweight, SoftFuse is our favorite for most projects. It is paper backed so you can easily trace your pattern on the paper backing and cut out your applique.

Misty Fuse is also super light weight, but it does not have a paper backing. A pressing sheet or parchment paper would need to be used with Misty Fuse to prevent it from

sticking to something else or for drawing on a pattern.

Steam a Seam is a bit thicker and the feel will be a bit more noticeable on your project. Steam a Seam is a bit tacky when you are working with it. This tackiness allows it to temporarily hold in place while you are laying out your design. This tackiness is just a temporary adhesive. The permanent glue is not activated until it is heated with an iron.

Heat n Bond comes in two varieties, one can be sewn and one cannot. You want to make sure you purchase the right product for your intended use. Heat n Bond is the thickest of the fusible webs and you will definitely be able to feel it in your finished project. It is the least expensive of the fusible webs. Heat n Bond Ultrabond (red packaging) cannot be sewn through. Because of this it has three times the hold of other fusible webs.

Each fusible web requires a different amount of ironing time. Make sure you read the direction for whatever product you select. If you don't heat for long enough the glue will not activate. If you heat for too long you could melt the glue and your applique will not longer stick.

Next time you're in the shop, checkout our samples of each of the fusible webs. We've sandwiched each fusible web with two layers of cotton fabric so you can really see how they feel in use.

Gadgets for Fusible Applique

Glow Premium by CutterPillar

The Glow Premium Light Table makes it easy to trace your patterns. Plus lay your appli-fuse mat on top to easily arrange your applique pieces.

There are three different illumination levels on this super thin light table. The Glow Premium also comes with a non-slip self healing cutting mat. Best of all it has a rechargeable battery allowing you to use the light table for 3-4 hours without being plugged in. The lighted area is 12" x 16" and the board is 13" x 19." \$139.99





Appli-Fuse Mats by Gypsy Quarter

Place the applique design diagram under the Appli-Fuse Mat. The mat is transparent so cut applique shapes can be placed perfectly. The mat is heat resistant so press multiple layers together. The layered applique can now be picked up as one continuous piece. Small divots in the mat allow the glue to pool when heated and then harden right back in place. This means you won't have any seepage of glue from the design and your edges remain crisper. **Multiple Sizes Available**

Applique Pressing Sheet by Bear Thread Designs


The Applique Pressing Sheet is reusable, double sided and made from ultra high temperature glass, coated with non-stick Polylon. The coating is nonstick making it perfect to use with any fusible product (fusible web, interfacing, etc) because you won't have to worry about any fusible sticking to the mat. No picture is included because the pressing sheet is completely clear allowing you to see your applique pattern for placement! The pressing sheet is also multipurpose and can be used for hot glue guns, wax designs, fabric stiffener, glue projects, rubber stamps, embossing, paint and even in the oven to bake shrink-art, clay, salt dough, etc. It is 18" x 20". \$21.99



Vinyl Weeding Tool by Embellish

The weeding tool has a micro pointed end making removing unwanted vinyl a breeze. Jennifer loves it for applique because it is great for scoring the back of the release paper in the center of your design. By scoring the center and removing your edges remain crisper. It has a slight weight to it so it handles well in your hand. \$14.99

CLASS POLICIES

Call, visit our website, or stop in to sign up and pay for the class of your choice. Class fee is due when you register.

The class supply list will be available when you register and pay for the class. Supplies are not included in the class fee unless otherwise specified. Please have supplies purchased before class. Kits required are available at the store. No photocopied or sharing of patterns or books will be allowed in classes.

Please be setup and ready to begin class at the specified time.

We consider your enrollment to be a commitment to take the class and we in turn make a commitment to the instructor. No cancellations are allowed on classes. Thank you for not asking us to make exceptions.

Your sewing machine or serger must be in top working condition before you arrive at class. Students whose equipment is not working properly disturb and slow down the class. We service all brands of machines and sergers so come see us prior to the start of the class.

CLASSES

BEGINNING QUILTING

Wednesday, May 11, 18, 25, & June 1 1:00-4:00 pm or 6:00-9:00 pm

Do you want to learn to quilt or improve your skills? This is the class for you; no experience needed. At the end of the 4 sessions, you will have learned the basic skills of quilt making: fabric selection, rotary cutting,



accurate piecing, quilting, and binding. In the first class, we'll be discussing tools and selecting fabrics. A 20% discount will be given on supplies purchased during the first class. We want to make sure your quilt is completed at the end of the four sessions, so there will be homework each week. Bring your own machine. Class fee is \$75 plus supplies and book. **This is the last class until next fall!**

GRANDMA'S BLESSINGS

Grandma's Blessings, Block of the Month is a great technique builder. Each month Sandy will show you how to create these classic blocks with a modern twist. You'll be piecing the blocks slightly oversized and using the Studio 180 tools to trim the blocks to the precise size.

Bring your sewing machine and create your monthly blocks in class. The class is only open to those participating in the Grandma's Blessings Block of the Month. For May's block we'll be using the Magic Wand and Wing Clipper to create flying geese.

Control the clutter with these sturdy zippered bins in three versatile sizes. Vinyl front windows afford quick and easy identification of contents. A zippered mesh pocket in the lid is a perfect place to store instructions or small pieces. Convenient handles on top and on each side make it easy to move and carry the bins.

New Owners Class




