


THREAD PAINTING & FREE MOTION QUILTING— WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?

For both thread painting and free motion quilting, you drop the feed dogs on your sewing machine. Without feed dogs, there is nothing to push the fabric forward on your

sewing machine. You are now in control of moving your fabric around and determining the stitch length. You will also want to switch to a free motion foot. We prefer the open toe variety, so you can see right where your needle will drop. While the initial process is very similar the actual execution of the two techniques is very different.

With free motion quilting, you are layering a backing, batting, and quilt top together and quilting the three layers by moving your fabric under the needle. Usually you are using a 50 weight or finer cotton thread (but that's not a hard and fast rule—there are no quilt police). Stitching usually complements your quilt top but is not the star of



the show. Free motion quilting is usually not super dense (although it could be) and you will likely not stitch over the same line of stitching more than twice if at all. While you can do any pattern you dream up (and "draw" while moving your fabric), there are a number of common free motion quilting patterns: stipple, pebble, spirals, loops, flowers, and switchbacks. Kelly's free motion quilting class was such a hit in October, that she is

offering the same class again in November.



Thread painting starts out the same, by dropping the feed dogs, but the effect is much different. With thread painting, you are creating a design to be the star of your project. A 40 weight polyester thread is

usually used to really help the thread stand out. The thread is usually layered many times to again help it to stand out. The same thread may be used or multiple colors may be used to add depth and shadowing. Thread painting is usually done on a single layer of fabric with a stabilizer. These items are both hooped in a wooden embroidery hoop. This gives you something to hold onto as you complete your stitching. A pattern can be drawn on the wash away stabilizer to give yourself a guide for stitching or you can just start stitching. Thread painting can be used to create a design to give you the look of embroidery. Or it can also be used to add detailing on an

applique like the veins of a leaf. Linda Bratten, a thread painting expert is traveling to Fargo November 10-12 for an event at Country Inn & Suites. She has SEW many tips and techniques to share. You're sure to fall in love with thread painting.



Guide to Gadgets making your life easier

Gadgets for Thread Painting 8 Free Motion Quilting


Stick 'N Stitch by Sulky

Draw a design (or print from your computer) onto Stick 'N Stitch. Remove the protective backing and it will stick to right to





one gadget at a time



Grid Glider by Sew Steady

Do you wish your quilt slid a little easier over your extension table? The grid glider uses micro suction technology to temporarily adhere to the bed of your sewing machine and extension table creating a slick sewing surface. A hole is already precut for your needle. The grid glider is 12" x 20" but can easily be cut down with scissors if you need a smaller area. This mat is repositionable so when you're done just peel it off and roll it up to store it for next time.





Accu-Grip Quilting Gloves

Quilting gloves make it easier for you to control your fabric while quilting. The grips on these gloves cover the palm area leaving the rest of your fingers exposed, so you can still easily thread your needle or answer a text without having to take off your gloves.

Machingers by Quilters Touch

If you prefer a quilting glove with more coverage, machingers are for you. You wear them just like a winter glove, except there is extra grip on the fingertips. They come in four different sizes so everyone can get their perfect fit.













THREAD PAINTING

with Linda Bratten, Baby Lock Educator

November 10-12

Country Inn & Suites

Drop your feed dogs and you're ready to Thread Paint! No experience necessary! Linda Bratten will teach you all you need to know to get started thread sketching and painting. Over the course of the three day event, you'll create two fun fall projects:

- Falling in Love Mini Quilt featuring raw edge applique and thread painted leaves
- Pumpkin Spice featuring Thread Sketched Pumpkin and Dye-na-Flow Painting
- and learn a new technique you'll want to use over and over on other projects

On Friday & Saturday, the event will run from 10 am - 6 pm with instruction from Linda Bratten. Sunday will be an open sew day from 10 am - 4 pm. Finish up your thread painting or bring another project. You may also have some open sew time on Friday & Saturday.

The cost of the event is \$299. This includes patterns, background fabrics, and Dye-na-Flow Paint. Lunch on Friday & Saturday is also included. You will need to bring your sewing machine with free motion quilting foot as well as a few other supplies.





We all have a number of UFOs (Unfinished Objects) laying around our sewing room. Maybe all the blocks are sewn but you just can't find the motivation to add the sashing. Or maybe you picked out all the fabrics and found just the right pattern but you just can't seem to make the first cut. And then there's those mystery projects that have been in the tote so long you have no idea how much work is left to finish them - it might be a pleasant surprise or it might be a ton of work.

The UFO Crusher Club is here to help you finish those projects! There's satisfaction in finishing the project, but for a little extra motivation, we'll have prizes each month. Each month we'll draw a number. You'll have until the next club meeting to complete that particular project from your list. Completed projects must be brought in during the next club meeting for show and tell or posted in the Facebook group (Rae-Bon Sewists) to be eligible for prizes.

Let's talk Prizes!

- Just for signing up you'll receive a UFO project tag/keychain.
- Everyone who turns in a completed project will be eligible for our monthly prize drawing. Or maybe everyone
 will get a prize it will vary by month. In October, everyone with a completed project enjoyed a bag of Stellar
 Pretzels.
- Every completed project also gets you an entry into the grand prize valued at over \$250.

Do I need to come in the shop? Can't I just participate online?

The UFO Crushers Club is also a social gathering. Each month, you can stop in the shop to visit with your fellow quilters and see what they're working on. Or maybe you want a little advice on how to finish your project or what fabric you should add. They'll be a room full of other quilters to offer they're opinions!

Plus if you need a little extra motivator to make the trip into the shop, we'll have special sales just during the club meeting. Things we know you'll need to finish those projects!

Oh No! I can't possibly complete the selected project this month. Do I have any options?

You joined this club for a push and deadline to complete your projects. But we know life happens and we want you to feel good about your progress. So we will allow one swap & one substitution during the year. Let us know of the change when you turn in your completed project and will notate you used your swap or substitution.

- Swap We drew #6, but you really need to get project #2 done this month. Swap the numbers of two projects.
- Substitution #5 was your stretch project and there is just no way you can get it done this month. Pick a project from your stash that was not on your original list. The original project will no longer be on your list.

This sounds great! How do I sign up?

To sign up, pay your \$50 membership fee (that's a low price of about \$4 per month) and turn in your list of 12 projects you plan to finish this year. The membership fee can also be paid online and the list emailed to reddoor@rae-bon.com. Projects can include embroidery, quilting, bag sewing, knitting, etc. Keep in mind you will have roughly 30 days to complete the project once the number has been drawn, so be realistic.

For November's meeting, please complete project #7. You can leave project #10 blank as that was completed for October.

Note: We encourage you to finish all projects in their entirety (even binding). But we know some of you prefer to quilt by check, so for those projects larger than 36" x 36" a completed top will count as a finished project.

CLASSES

ADVANCED BEGINNER QUILTING: QUEEN'S PETTICOAT PILLOW

Monday, November 6, 20, & 27 2:30 - 5:30 pm or 6:00 - 9:00 pm

Have you completed beginning quilting and your wondering what's next? Our Advanced Beginner Quilting classes are the perfect next step. Each class series will



focus on a different common quilt block that you'll see over and over again in quilts. In this advanced beginner class, we'll be focusing on the Combination and Hourglass Blocks. It can be difficult to sew so the diagonals exactly bisect the square. We have some great tips to help you easily and accurately sew these blocks. Just like Beginning Quilting, the goal is for you to finish the pillow at the end of the three sessions, so there will be homework each session.

Class I: You've already learned to cut your fabric during Beginning Quilting, so we'll have you do that ahead of time and we can get right to the sewing. During the first class, you'll learn to sew hourglass blocks, half square triangles, and combination units. You'll use the Tucker Trimmer to perfectly trim down each block. You'll also be sewing 4 patches.

Class 2: During the second class, you'll use all the blocks you've created to assemble the Queen's Petticoat Block and quilt your pillow top.

Class 3: For the final class, you'll learn how to create piping for the edge of your pillow. You'll also insert a zipper in the pillow back. You'll leave this class with a finished pillow that you can pop a pillow form in at home.

Completion of Beginning Quilting is not a prerequisite for Advanced Beginner Quilting, but you do need to be comfortable with basic quilting skills including cutting fabric, 1/4" seam, and pressing.

The \$75 class fee includes nine hours of instruction time and printed pattern. You'll need to bring your sewing machine and basic sewing supplies each week. You'll also need to select fabric prior to class. We encourage you to purchase your fabric at Rae-Bon to better ensure a high quality finished product.

Machine Rental Available for Classes

The Baby Lock Brilliant is available to rent during instructor led classes. A limited number of machines are available on a first come first serve basis. We recommend reserving a machine when you sign up for class. Rental is not available during Open Sew.

The Baby Lock Brilliant is a wonderful sewing machine with some great bells and whistles. It features 190 stitches, thread cutter, needle threader, and speed control. A variety of feet are included with the machine: walking foot, nonstick foot, 1/4" guide foot, zipper foot, and more (14 total feet).

The rental fee is \$25 per session* and includes use of the machine and 14 snap on feet. In order to not take away from

class time for yourself or other students, you must arrive 30 minutes before class starts to sign a rental contract and inventory the machine accessories. A staff member will also provide an overview on use of the machine at that time. At the end of class, a staff member will again complete an inventory with you. You are responsible for any missing accessories or damage to the machine. In order to ensure the machines stay in good working order, thread must be purchased from Rae-Bon Sew & Quilt Shop.

*If you decide to purchase the machine at the end of class, your rental fee can be applied to the purchase
