DID YOU HEAR THE NEWS?

Rae-Bon Sew & Quilt Shop has been selected as a Top 10 Shop by Quilt Sampler Magazine and Better Homes & Gardens! Our feature will appear in the Fall/Winter 2022 Issue on newsstands September 9.

The road to being featured in Quilt Sampler Magazine started a little over a year ago. Sandy and Jennifer submitted an extensive application process with a detailed history of the shop, current happenings at the shop, and photos. A panel at Quilt Sampler reviewed all the applications and selects the top 10 shop from the over 3,000 eligible shops.

Sandy received the phone call that Rae-Bon Sew & Quilt Shop was selected about six months ago, but had to keep it a secret. The first step was for Jennifer to design the quilt that would appear in the magazine. Designs of three different quilts in two different colorways were submitted to the magazine and they selected their favorite. Luckily their favorite and ours was the same! As soon as it was selected Jennifer had less than a month to create the most important quilt of her life. The piecing went together just as planned featuring shades of blue and teal. Thanks to trimming with the Wing Clipper tool all of the points on the flying geese turned out perfectly. Quilting is really visible in photos, so the quilting needed to be really special. The custom quilting took about four days to get just right. The ability to cut out different areas with the Prostitcher on the Baby Lock Regalia made it easy to quilt something different in the background versus the flying geese blocks. Ruler work was used to stitch in the ditch on each of the improv blocks.

Once the quilt was in the mail, next up was the shop profile. Sandy and Jennifer completed a phone interview with the writer. From the interview and the application the writer decided what to focus on from our shop. Remember that day the shop was closed for staff training? That was a little white lie. A photographer and stylist were actually here that day photographing the shop.

Before the magazine went to print, Sandy and Jennifer were able to get a glimpse of the pattern and shop profile. Quilt Sampler did a great job of capturing the shop. Magazines will be available as soon as they hit newsstands (or maybe a little before). The actual quilt featured in the magazine should be back in the shop any day now. Quilt Sampler keeps the physical quilt until the first printing of the magazine comes back so they can compare colors. Jennifer and Sandy each stitched up the quilt, Night Flight in two different colorways so you can see it now. Preorder your quilt kit today so you can pick it up as soon as the magazines arrive in the shop. Jennifer will also be teaching classes on Night Flight in September and October to help you create the featured quilt.

When creating the improv flying geese you will end up with quite a few improv pieced half square triangles. A handful of bonus projects were created to help you use those scraps. Everyone who purchases a kit, will receive these patterns as a free download.

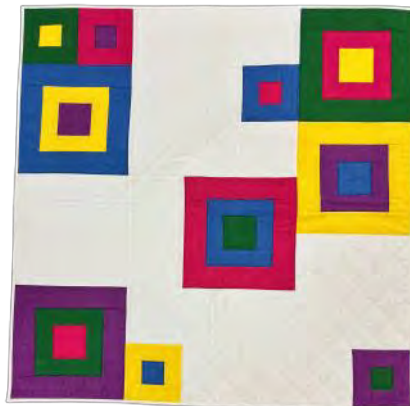
CLASSES

BEGINNING QUILTING

Thursday, September 8, 15, 22, & 29
1:00 - 4:00 pm or 6:00 - 9:00 pm

Do you want to learn to quilt or improve your skills? This is the class for you; no experience needed. At the end of the 4 sessions, you will have learned the basic skills of quilt making: fabric selection, rotary cutting,

accurate piecing, quilting, and binding. In the first class, we'll be discussing tools and selecting fabrics. A 20% discount will be given on supplies purchased during the first class. We want to make sure your quilt is completed at the end of the four sessions, so there will be homework each week. Bring your own sewing machine. Class fee is \$75 plus supplies and book.



GRANDMA'S BLESSINGS

Grandma's Blessings, block of the month is a great technique builder. Each month Sandy will show you how to create these classic blocks with a modern twist. You'll be piecing the blocks slightly oversized and using the Studio 180 tools to trim the blocks to the precise size. Bring your sewing machine and create your monthly blocks in class. The class is only open to those participating in the Grandma's Blessings Block of the Month.

For September's block we'll be using the Magic Wand and the Wing Clipper to make Dual Colored Flying Geese.



LEARN TO USE YOUR SCANNCUT

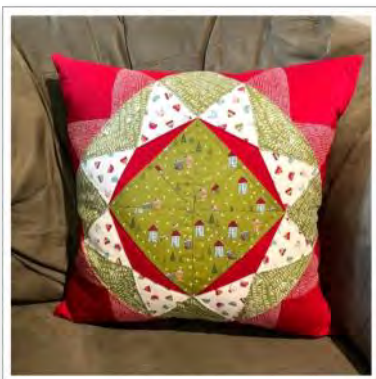

Were you wowed by a ScanNCut demo but are a little nervous to get started? Or maybe you just know there is more you could be doing with your ScanNCut? We've got a class for you!

Jennifer has created a five session class covering a range of the ScanNCut features. Each session will build on previous knowledge so you become an expert on the ScanNCut and CanvasWorkspace. It's easier to remember what different features do and why you would want to use them when making an actual project, so Jennifer has curated a collection of projects across a range of crafts. You'll create beautiful things while learning all your machine can do. We hope you'll love all the projects but if some of them are not your style or interest, please remember you're learning the techniques! Once you have these valuable skills you'll be able to apply them to future projects that you dream up. The class will meet on the second Monday from September-January from 1-5 pm.

The materials you need to create each project are included in your class fee. These classes are your opportunity to try out lots of different techniques and materials to see what you like. No need to buy an entire roll of foil if that's not your cup of tea. We'll have a sample for you to use in class. But if you love the fusible web we're testing out, we will have some on hand for you to purchase.

You will need to bring your ScanNCut to class each session as well as any ScanNCut consumables (mats, blades, etc.) and some basic crafting supplies. A supply list will be provided each session so you know what to bring. Some sessions we will be using CanvasWorkspace, Brother's free

online software for editing and creating cutting files. For these sessions you will need to bring a laptop so you can get hands on practice.

The ScanNCut class is only open to those with a machine from the DX series (machines with an auto blade). The kit fee (\$175) will include all the materials for each project and a workbook to walk you through each lesson. There is no class fee if your ScanNCut was purchased at Rae-Bon Sew & Quilt Shop. The class fee is \$150 for machines purchased elsewhere.

Materials provided for each project may vary from the color or print pictured.

Class I

Let's get the ScanNCut out of the box! It's okay if you've never used your machine. We'll start with the basics this session and cut a couple of built in designs. We'll also go over different setting options and tools built into your machine.

Projects: Framed Quilt Block and Wood Ornament



Materials to Cut: cotton fabric and iron on foil

Sampling of Skills You'll Learn: fussy cutting, drawing seam allowances, resizing designs, and weeding

Class 2

While the ScanNCut works without a computer, CanvasWorkspace really expands what you can create. Brother also offer a ton of ready to go projects for you within CanvasWorkspace. This session we'll setup a CanvasWorkspace account and play with some of the basic features. Laptop required.

Projects: Cork Notebook Cover, Tear Away Gift Tags & Vinyl Text for Framed Quilt Block

Materials: cork, cardstock, and vinyl

Sampling of Skills You'll Learn: exporting files from CanvasWorkspace, importing SVG files, adding text for cutting and drawing, and how to layer vinyl



Class 3

The ScanNCut makes cutting out appliques a breeze. Did you know the ScanNCut can read a pes file? We'll cut applique for machine embroidery. We'll also use a printed pattern to create a cut file.

Projects: Cupcake Zippered Pouch, Hello Spring Banner, and Camera Applique Mug Rug

Materials: fabric with a variety of fusible web and OESD glitter vinyl

Sampling of Skills You'll Learn: working with a pes file, scan to cut data, adding an offset, and utilizing the drawing tool



Class 4

CanvasWorkspace allows you to create your own cut files. This session we'll dive deeper into all CanvasWorkspace can do. Laptop required.

Projects: Collection of Greeting Cards

Materials: cardstock, transparency film
