PROJECTS ON THE GO

It's sew nice to have a small project you can toss in your bag and take with you to work on when you have a little downtime. At Rae-Bon Sew & Quilt Shop, we've gotten in a number of new kits to help you try out a new hobby or just have a little project you can create on the go.

Crochet

Crochet involves using a hook to interlock loops of yarn. The biggest difference between knitting and crocheting is that with crocheting a stitch is complete before the next one is begun. Whereas with knitting, many stitches are kept open at a time. Rae-Bon Sew & Quilt Shop now carries a range of crochet kits from Toft. These kits include everything you need to make adorable animals and vegetables. Best of all they include a link to free online tutorials so if you're a novice crocheter you'll have great video instruction to get you going. Toft is based in the UK and has a focus on quality making sure to source the finest yarns and other products. They also have a focus on sustainability and animal welfare so you can feel good about your purchases from this brand.



Needle Punch

Needle punch is definitely making a come back. It can be used to make wall hangings, pillows, or even embellish garments. Thread is passed through the eye and central core of a special needle. The needle is then punched into the fabric to create a looped stitch. For most projects, you will be working from the wrong side of the project and the loops will be the right side.

Rae-Bon carries Smart Punch an ergonomically designed punch needle. This new punch needle really makes a big difference in comfort with needle punching. You can use a variety of threads to punch. We've used 4 strands of Cosmo floss on our sample. You could also use Eleganza. We have a variety of patterns to get you started and we'll have a class on Wednesday, September 6 if you'd like a little help getting started.

Needle Felting

Needle felting involved using a unique needle with tiny barbs on the end. The needle is repeatedly stabbed into wool to tangle the fibers and lock them together. This

allows you to create flat or 3D structures from wool roving. Rae-Bon has two kits perfect for the holidays to get you started. Both include all the supplies you need to make the projects as well as full color illustrated instructions.



Hand Embroidery

Hand Embroidery is a fun way to add texture and design to fabric. You can even create full scenes or landscapes. All you need is a needle, fabric, and thread. There are so many different types of hand embroidery stitches it can feel a bit overwhelming to get started, but we have some great kits that focus on basic stitches to get you started. A couple of kits make pendants or broaches. Many others make pieces to frame or sew into a larger project. Each kit includes all the supplies you need plus full color instructions.



Knitting

With knitting, you are working in rows leaving multiple stitches open at a time. Currently Rae-Bon has two kits with two different styles of knitting. The wooly wreath ornament is made by knitting on your fingers. The kit includes bulky yarn to create the wreaths and a bit of

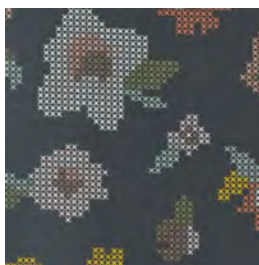
velvet ribbon for the bow. The second kit makes a set of knitted roses complete with leaves. Knitting needles are used to create these. Both kits include very thorough full color photographed instructions and online videos. So if you've never knitted before you'll be able to easily pick it up.



Cross Stitch

Cross Stitch is a form of hand embroidery involving only one stitch, the X. The stitch is created on an open weave cloth where you can count the squares. Rae-Bon has a number of patterns and aida cloth colors to choose from. We also carry the full line of Cosmo Floss. The floss is the highest quality on the market. It is colorfast and glides through your cloth with ease. We also carry a number of kits if you'd like to grab a package with everything included.

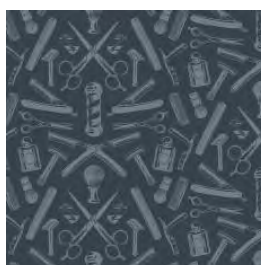

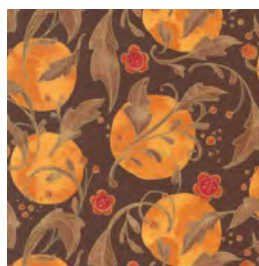

Ink & Stain Remover by Amodex

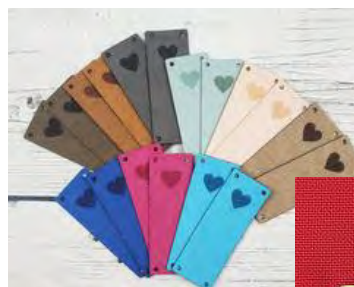


There's nothing worse than working hard on a project and then you wash it and the red bleeds onto the white fabric. Or your Frixion pen makes a reappearance on your quilt top. Or a food stain on your favorite shirt. Amodex Ink & Stain Remover to the rescue! This product works marvelously to remove a wide range of stains. Most stain removers are a solvent, but Amodex is a soap. This allows it to sit on a stain for extended periods of time without causing any damage to the fabric. Jennifer found patience really was the key when using Amodex. She had turmeric chicken explode all over her black & white lunchbox. Amodex sat on the stain for about 24 hours and completely removed it. No elbow grease necessary.

Uff Da! Having to rip out a seam is always annoying, but make it a little more fun with an adorable wood seam ripper.



Scissor Tags by Katrinkles

Do all your scissors look alike? Are other people using your fabric scissors on paper? These handy scissor tags will solve all your problems. Each tag is cut from cherry wood. They are light weight, look a bit fancy, and are very practical. Each tag also includes a color coded chain. The package includes three tags: For Paper Only, For Thread Only, For Fabric Only.



Faux Suede & Wood Tags by Katrinkles



These new tags from Katrinkles are perfect to add a little extra embellishments to your projects. Katrinkles is a small business out of Rhode Island. They make everything by hand in their shop.

The faux suede tags are all 100% vegan and machine washable. The tags add a little extra whimsy to quilts, bags, and garments. Rae-Bon has three different styles.

The "Made In . . ." Tags are available for North Dakota, South Dakota, and Minnesota. They are made from birch and are hand sanded to ensure there are no sharp edges.

Get Your Machine Cleaned Up for all your UFO Sewing!



Steve, our service technician, is factory trained by Baby Lock, Brother, Pfaff, and Viking and can service all makes and models of machines. Steve's turn around time is currently less than a week. Although this may vary depending on the number of machines in for service.

Why do I need to have my sewing machine serviced?

There are many moving parts in a sewing machine and if it moves, it needs lubrication. These days many of the moving parts are housed with computer circuit boards and wires around them and are inaccessible to the home sewer. A factory trained technician needs to open up the machine to lubricate parts that you are unable to access as well as clean areas you are unable to reach. For best performance and years of sewing, we suggest you have your machine serviced annually.

CLASSES

LEARN TO SEW

Sign Up

Wednesday, September 20, 27, & October 4
1:00 - 4:00 pm or 6:00 - 9:00 pm

Learn beginner sewing skills including how to use a sewing machine, fabric selection, and making three useful projects during this three session class.

Class 1: During the first class you'll meet the Baby Lock Brilliant Sewing Machine and learn all about how a basic sewing machine works: threading, winding a bobbin, selecting your stitch and more. Jump into your first project by stitching up a pillowcase to take home at the end of the first class. We'll help you select fabric and you'll learn to use a rotary cutter, mat, and ruler for perfectly straight cuts.

Class 2: You'll learn to sew a tote bag with interior pockets. While making the tote you'll learn how to install handles, boxing bag corners, topstitching, and more.

Class 3: For the final class, we'll tackle one of everyone's biggest fears . . . zippers! But no need to be afraid, thanks to our tips you'll be ready to sew zippers in everything. You'll leave class with a lined zipper bag.

The \$75 class fee includes nine hours of instruction time, three printed patterns, and use of the Baby Lock Brilliant Sewing Machine. You will also need to purchase fabric and supplies during each class. To give you an idea additional supplies for class will cost approximately \$50. Your cost will vary based on fabrics selected.



BEGINNING QUILTING

Do you want to learn to quilt or improve your skills? This is the class for you; no quilting experience needed. However you do need to be comfortable with basic operation of your sewing machine including winding a bobbin, threading your



machine, and sewing a straight line. At the end of the four sessions, you will have learned the basic skills of quilt making while making a table topper. We want to make sure your quilt is completed at the end of the four sessions, so there will be homework each week.

Class 1: We'll be discussing tools and selecting fabrics. You'll also learn the basics of using a rotary cutter, mat, and ruler to cut your fabric.

Class 2: You'll need to bring your sewing machine to this class. We'll discuss sewing with an accurate 1/4" seam and start piecing your blocks.

Class 3: It's your first quilt so your blocks may not have turned out exactly the right size. It's okay! Diane will help you square up your blocks and determine how to cut your background so everything fits together. We'll also discuss various ways to quilt your table topper and you'll get started quilting.

Class 4: This week you'll finish up the quilting and learn how to finish off the edges with binding.

The \$99 class fee includes 12 hours of instruction. The book, *New Patchwork and Quilting Basics* is needed for class (\$24.95). This book is a great resource for quilting basics and includes many great project patterns. You will need to bring your own sewing machine to class starting with the second week or rent one of ours (\$25 per session). During the first session, we'll discuss the tools needed for quilting and help you select fabric. On average students spend \$50-\$150 on fabric and additional supplies.

ADVANCED BEGINNER QUILTING: FLYING GEESSE RUNNER

Tuesday, September 19, 26, & October 3
1:00 - 4:00 pm or 6:00 - 9:00 pm

Have you completed beginning quilting and your wondering what's next? Advanced Beginner Quilting classes are the perfect next step. Each class series will focus on a different common quilt block that you'll see over and over again in quilts. The Flying Geese block can be tricky to sew without losing one of the points. We have some great tips to help you easily and accurately sew this block. Just like Beginning Quilting, the goal is for you to finish the runner at the end of the three session, so there will be homework each session.



Class 1: You've already learned to cut your fabric during Beginning Quilting, so we'll have you do that ahead of time and we can get right to the sewing. During the first class, you'll learn to sew individual Flying Geese blocks and sew Flying Geese four at a time.

Class 2: Have you ever had trouble getting seams to match up? Nesting seams is the solution. You'll learn that and how to attach borders on your table runner this week.

Class 3: This week we'll do a slight twist on binding and add a flange.

Completion of Beginning Quilting is not a prerequisite for Advanced Beginner Quilting, but you do need to be comfortable with basic quilting skills including cutting fabric, 1/4" seam, and pressing.

The \$75 class fee includes nine hours of instruction time and printed pattern. You'll need to bring basic sewing supplies and your sewing machine or you may rent one of our machines (\$25 per session). Fabric needs to be selected prior to class. We encourage you to purchase your fabric at Rae-Bon to better ensure a high quality finished product.

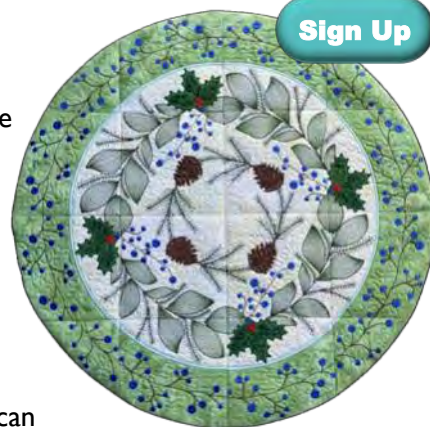
MACHINE EMBROIDERY

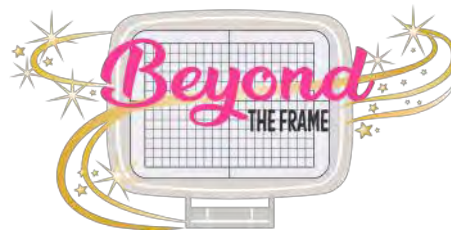
Everything is machine embroidery - the Holly is applique, the rest of the greens are embroidered. This topper is available in two sizes 5" blocks (19.5" finished) or 7" blocks (27.5" finished). The class is free with purchase of the HoopSisters Embroidery USB and Battilizer pack. Bring your embroidery machine, printed instructions, and precut fabric.

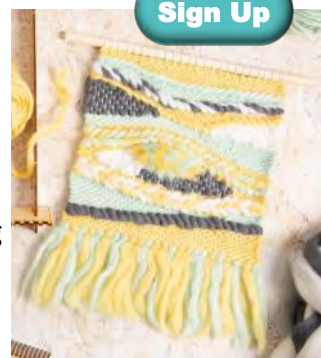

Machine Rental Now Available for Classes

The Baby Lock Brilliant is available to rent during instructor led classes. A limited number of machines are available on a first come first serve basis. We recommend reserving a machine when you sign up for class. Rental is not available during Open Sew.

The Baby Lock Brilliant is a wonderful sewing machine with some great bells and whistles. It features 190 stitches, thread cutter, needle threader, and speed control. A variety of feet are included with the machine: walking foot, nonstick foot, 1/4" guide foot, zipper foot, and more (14 total feet).

The rental fee is \$25 per session* and includes use of the machine and 14 snap on feet. In order to not take away from class time for yourself or other students, you must arrive 30 minutes before class starts to sign a rental contract and inventory the machine accessories. A staff member will also provide an overview on use of the machine at that time. At the end of class, a staff member will again complete an inventory with you. You are responsible for any missing accessories or damage to the machine. In order to ensure the machines stay in good working order, thread must be purchased from Rae-Bon Sew & Quilt Shop.

*If you decide to purchase the machine at the end of class, your rental fee can be applied to the purchase



New Owners Class

Explore the features and stitches of your new sewing machine. You will stitch samples, learn the functions of your machine, and basic cleaning. Open to Baby Lock, Brother, Pfaff, and Viking owners. No charge for machines purchased at Rae-Bon; \$75.00 for others.

New Owners Classes are by appointment. Please call the shop at 433-7203 to arrange a time. Bring your machine, accessory feet, foot control, power cord, spool of thread, and bobbin.

A new owners class is also available to learn the basics of machine embroidery. In class you'll learn the functions of your embroidery machine, stabilizer recommendations, hooping tips, and more. No charge for machines purchased at Rae-Bon; \$150 for others.

Your sewing machine or serger must be in top working condition before you arrive at class. Students whose equipment is not working properly disturb and slow down the class. We service all brands of machines and sergers so come see us prior to the start of the class.
