### **CLASSES**

#### **BEGINNING QUILTING**

Wednesday, January 8, 15, 22, & 29: 1:00-4:00 pm or 6:00-9:00 pm

Saturday, February I & March 7: 10:00 am-4:00 pm

At the end of the 4 sessions (or two Saturday Sessions), you will have learned the basic skills of quilt making: fabric selection, rotary cutting, accurate piecing, adding borders, quilting, and



binding. Come to the first class with your supplies or you can come early and purchase right before class starts. We will be cutting fabric and sewing during the first class. There will be homework to be prepared for the next session. 20% discount will be given for purchases listed on the supply list. Supply list will be given when you register for the class. No experience necessary. Bring your own machine. Class fee is \$75 plus supplies and book.

#### **BEGINNING SEWING: ZIPPERED BAG**

Tuesday, January 28: 1:00-4:00 pm or 6:00-9:00 pm

If you have little to no sewing experience, this class is for you! In this class, you'll learn basic straight stitching, how to install a zipper, and how to topstitch while making a zipper bag. The class fee is \$40 and



includes all supplies, use of a Baby Lock machine and tools needed. You'll be able to make the bag your own by selecting your own fabric and label. If you would prefer, you can bring your own sewing machine. You must know basic operation of the machine prior to class. This class will teach basic sewing and construction techniques, not how to use your particular machine. Please see the section on New Owners Classes if you are interested in a class on operating your sewing machine. Class is open to those 16 and older.

#### **CLAM UP ZIPPERED POUCHES**

Tuesday, January 7: 1:00-4:00 pm or 6:00-9:00 pm

Zippered pouches in five sizes are perfect for storing and carrying makeup, sewing supplies, tech gear, and more. You may quilt the fabric or leave it unquilted and add optional



iron-on vinyl laminate for a wipe clean interior. Double Sided Zippers and handy grab tabs make the bags easy to open wide. We'll be making a medium Clam Up bag in class. Class fee is \$20. You will also need to purchase supplies and the pattern. Bring your sewing machine or borrow one of ours. Class is free for those in the Sew Creative Club.

Join us to make a wristlet bag for taking your projects on the go with you! The little bag would also make a great gift filled with a few soaps or lotions. The pattern also includes instructions for making a knitting needle keeper



(Keeps your stitches on the needles when your not working on your project.) Class fee is \$20. You will also need to purchase supplies and the pattern. Bring your sewing machine or borrow one of ours.

## HOOPSISTERS BLOCK OF THE MONTH: MOROCCAN SUNSET

Saturday, January 18: Classroom open from 10:00 am - 4:00 pm

Moroccan Sunset is a medallion quilt with intricate flying geese, curves, and beautiful decorative stitching. But it couldn't be easier because the entire quilt top is completed in the hoop! At the end, you



wouldn't even need to send the quilt off to the quilter because all the quilting is completed in the hoop! Once all the blocks are completed you will combine them with HoopSisters unique sashing technique to finish off all the edges. Following HoopSisters recommended backing colors you will end up with a reversible quilt. Join us in the classroom to work on this month's blocks. Are you a maker who enjoys creating things? Then you'll want this framed sewing machine and "I am a Maker" candle mat for your creative space. In this class we'll be working with wool felt and fabric to



make a cute little framed picture and a candle mat. No sewing machine needed for this project. You'll learn three easy hand stitches for assembling. Class fee of \$45 includes all supplies, pattern, and class instruction. No charge for those that bring their SewBusy Box Kit.

#### KIMBERBELL EMBROIDERY CLUB

#### **TEXTURED TO THE NINES PILLOW**

In this class, you'll learn three different blocks made by folding fabric. The blocks are then assembled into a gorgeous 12" pillow. Class fee is \$20 plus supplies and pattern. Class is free for those



who received a November 2018 SewBusy Box.

## TUCKER UNIVERSITY: RAPID FIRE LEMOYNE STAR

Thursday, January 16: 1:00-4:00 pm or 6:00-9:00 pm

A tool and technique that will allow you to quickly, easily, and accurately piece traditional Lemoyne Star blocks in 10 different sizes! The block units are strip pieced, assembled without using any Y



seams, and pieced slightly oversized so you can trim to the exact dimensions. Supply list given upon registration. Class fee is \$20.

#### **SEWCIAL HOUR**

Never enough time to get everything done? Join us to sew with friends (or make some new ones). The classroom is open for you to work on any unfinished projects (or start a new one).



Bring your machine and project to work on. Advance registration is required to reserve your spot.

## YOUTH SEWING: SPA DAY (AGES 8-15)

Saturday, January II: 1:00-4:00 pm

It's time for a new year, and time to take time for yourself! Come to the Youth Sew class in January, and we will be making a sleep mask and cleanser pads! What



could be better than a little bit of pampering? Class is limited to the first 6 students. See you then! Class fee of \$25 includes all project supplies and use of a Baby Lock machine. While not required, parents or grandparents are welcome to come assist their budding sewer.

#### **NEW OWNERS CLASS**

Explore the features and stitches of your new sewing machine. You will stitch samples, learn the functions of your machine, and basic cleaning. Open to Baby Lock, Pfaff, and Viking owners. No charge for machines purchased at Rae-Bon; \$50.00 for others. Bring your machine, accessory feet, foot control, power cord, spool of thread, and bobbin.

A new owners class is also available to learn the basics of machine embroidery. No charge for machines purchased at Rae-Bon; \$150 for others. New Owners Classes are by appointment. Please call the shop at 433-7203 to register.

#### **CLASS POLICIES**

Call or stop in to sign up and pay for the class of your choice. Class fee is due when you register. Phone registrations (701-433-7203) accepted only with a credit card payment.

The class supply list will be available when you register and pay for the class. Supplies are not included in the class fee unless otherwise specified. Please have supplies purchased before class. Kits required are available at the store. No photocopied or sharing of patterns or books will be allowed in classes.

We consider your enrollment to be a commitment by you to take the class and we in turn make a commitment to the instructor. No cancellations are allowed on classes. Thank you for not asking us to make exceptions.

Your sewing machine or serger must be in top working condition before you arrive at class. Students whose equipment is not working properly disturb and slow down the class. We service all brands of machines and sergers so come see us prior to the start of the class.

Do you like a challenge with a little more structure? Than this is the challenge for you. Everyone will be using the same pattern, "Handwork Take Along Clutch." but designing their own cover. Use any technique you'd like: applique, embroidery, fabric dying, English paper piecing, etc. to decorate the outside of your clutch. It's up to you!

The rules are simple:

- Purchase the pattern "Handwork Take Along Clutch" from Rae-Bon Sew & Quilt Shop
- Bring in your completed clutch by Saturday, February 8.

After February 8, clutches will be on display for two weeks for customers to vote on their favorite. The winner will receive a \$50 gift card.



Of this quilt Elizabeth Hartman says, "The animals of the African Savanna are amazing and iconic and I had so much fun turning some of them into patchwork blocks!" This 64" x 84" sampler quilt is made using conventional patchwork techniques. All pieces are square or rectangular except the rhino's horn, which is made using a cutting guide and a shortcut piecing technique similar to Lisa the Unicorn's horn or Norm and Nanette's hats.

This block of the month is available in the exact fabrics used by Elizabeth Hartman and feature her Adventure line, Kona solids, and Essex cotton/linen blend.


