SEWING WITH CUDDLE

As the weather turns cold nothing sounds better than to cuddle up on the couch with your dogs and a soft quilt. To make your quilts extra cuddly use Shannon Cuddle for the back. Shannon Cuddle comes in many different pile lengths from the original C3 cuddle to super thick faux furs. Any of the options are super soft and add extra luxury element to your quilts. You can also make your entire quilt or throw blanket out of cuddle for double the softness. As much as we love Cuddle, it can be a little intimidating to work with a new material, so we've got some tips to make sewing with Cuddle a breeze.

Cutting Cuddle can be a messy project. You'll notice at the cutting table we always keep a hand vacuum close by to suck up all the cuddle dust. Rotary cutting is the quickest but also the messiest way to cut Cuddle, so a hand vacuum is a great way to clean up. When rotary cutting you are cutting through the backing layer as well as the fibers underneath. For a less messy way of cutting cuddle, you can draw out your cut lines with a marker on the wrong side of the fabric. Then use a craft knife to cut through just the backing layer of cuddle. This way the ends of the fibers aren't cut and far less mess is created. Either way throw the newly cut Cuddle in the dyer on no heat for 10 minutes to eliminate the cuddle dust. Cuddle doesn't fray so the mess is just created from the initial cutting.

Once everything is cut, it's time to pin. Flower head pins are perfect for Cuddle because the larger flower head is easier to see in the thick pile of the Cuddle. It's also easiest if you pin using two layers of staggered pins. This

way when you sew you can remove the row closest to your foot so you don't stitch over them, but the second row stays in your fabric and prevents it from shifting. This method takes a bit longer and uses a lot of pins but the work will be well worth it when you go to sew.

A walking foot on your sewing machine is invaluable. With the thick material, you need a walking foot to ensure your machine feeds the material at the same rate. This will prevent stretching and shifting of the fabric. Increasing your stitch length to 3.5 or 4 will also help prevent distortion in your seam by allowing the fibers to nest together.

Use a 90/14 Stretch needle. with polyester thread. A stretch needle has a rounded tip so it will shift the weave of the fabric apart rather than piercing a hole through the fibers. A stretch needle also has a larger scarf making it easier for the thread to pass through the fabric. Cuddle is a knit polyester so it has a bit of stretch to it. Polyester thread also has a bit of stretch to it, so they work together well. If you used cotton thread, it may snap when the Cuddle stretches.

Sandy's Tip:

To contain Cuddle mess, cut it at a retreat! Let someone else do the vacuuming. We have a retreat coming up

Alligator Clamps by OESD

Alligator clamps have a unique hinged jaw enabling them to grab and manipulate thread or fabric in hard to reach places. This feature, combined with gripping teeth and long handles for increased leverage, makes this indispensable tool perfect for turning fabric in tight spots and pulling buttonettes in freestanding lace projects. \$20.99



Button Clips by OESD

one gadget at a time

Once you assemble a portion of your free standing lace structure it would be a shame if it fell apart while you worked on the next portion. Button clips securely hold the joint together by clipping over the connection while you assemble the rest of the item. 10 pack for \$4.99

BadgeMaster by OESD

BadgeMaster is a heavy-weight water-soluble stabilizer that is perfect for freestanding lace or freestanding applique projects. It rinses easily away with lukewarm water removing all traces of the stabilizer. We recommend one layer of BadgeMaster and one layer of Wet N Gone when creating freestanding lace sculptures. 12" x 8 yards. \$37.99




Take a mini vacation and spend a whole weekend sewing with friends!
