FINISHED QUILT SIZE 68" x 82"

Finished Block Size 12" x 12"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Rodeo Rider Fat Quarter Stack (FQ-4530-22)

1½ yards (1.4 m) blue main (C4530 Blue)

2 yards (1.85 m) cream stars (C4533 Cream)

Binding ⅝ yard (60 cm)

Backing 5 yards (4.6 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Fat Quarter Stack

Cut 2 squares 4½" x 4½" and 1 rectangle 4½" x 12½" from each of the following fat quarters.

blue main, brown main, cream main, blue paisley, cream paisley, blue horseshoe, cream horseshoe, brown stars, red stars, brown calico

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½" and 8 squares 2½" x 2½" from each of the following fat quarters.

blue main, brown main, cream main, blue paisley, cream paisley, blue horseshoe, cream horseshoe, blue stars, brown stars, brown calico

Cut 30 squares 2½" x 2½" from red stars.

Blue Main

Cut 7 strips 5½" x WOF for Border 1.

Cream Stars

Cut 10 strips 4½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 80 squares 4½" x 4½".

Cut 5 strips 2½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 80 squares 2½" x 2½".

Cut 17 strips 2½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 49 rectangles 2½" x 12½".

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics and blocks.


Plus Block

Refer to quilt photo for piece placement as each block is a different combination of fabrics. Sew a cream star 4½" square to each side of a print 4½" square to create Unit A. Repeat to create 20 Unit As.

Sew a Unit A to each side of a print 4½" x 12½" rectangle to create the Plus Block. Repeat to create 10 Plus Blocks.




Plus Block

Chain Block

Refer to quilt photo for piece placement as each block is a different combination of fabrics. Sew 2 print 2½" squares and 2 cream star 2½" squares together to create a Four-Patch Unit. Repeat to create 40 Four-Patch Units.

Referring to quilt photo for unit placement, sew 4 Four-Patch Units, 4 cream star 4½" squares, and a print 4½" square together to create the Chain Block. Repeat to create 10 Chain Blocks.

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Posts and Sashing

Refer to quilt photo for post and sashing placement. Sew a red star 2½" square to a cream star 2½ x 12½" rectangle. Repeat to make a row with 5 posts and 4 sashing rectangles. Make 6 post and sashing rows.

Sashing and Blocks

Refer to quilt photo for block and sashing placement. Sew a cream star 2½ x 12½" rectangle to a Plus or Chain Block. Repeat to make a row with 5 sashing rectangles and 4 blocks. Make 5 sashing and block rows.

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to quilt photo for row placement. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Border

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 72½". Top and bottom borders should be 68½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Rodeo Rider Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
