## Clarification of How to Use Cutting Charts.

When viewing the cutting chart, across the top of the chart the columns are titled:
Fabric Yardage \# of Strips Subcuts
In the \# of Strips column, an example of what it may say is:

- $4 \times 6$ " $\times$ LOF. This means you should cut 4 strips -6 " wide $\times$ Length of Fabric.
- $3 \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF. This means you should cut 3 strips $-41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide $x$ Width of Fabric.

Directly across from a notation in the Subcuts column, it will tell you how to Subcut that strip, or to hold it for further instruction later in the pattern.

## Page 6 Corrections:

Step 16 - Strip Set 5: Repeat to complete 14 squares (queen) or 16 squares (king).
Step 18: The C-4/C-5 rectangle should be rotated one third of the time.
Step 21 - Strip Set 7: Cut each strip set into $4-4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 8 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
Step 24: Repeat for a total of 8 rectangles. D-4/D-5 rectangle should be rotated half of the time.
Step 25: Lay out block. Pay attention to rotation of squares created in Step 24 ...
