

Sewing Caddy Instructions

Materials:

3 fat quarters - 1 for front, 1 for back and 1 for binding
1 quilt batting an inch larger on all 4 sides than fat quarters
1 quilt batting for pocket 18" x 6"
1 piece of fabric for embroidery pockets 18" x 12"
3 embroidery designs
3 Mylar sheets to fit 4x4 hoop
Medium weight stabilizer
Spray adhesive
Various thread colors

Step 1 - Embroidery

Separate your 18" x 12" fabric into 3 equal squares and mark the center of each square. Center each square in your hoop, placing a mylar sheet on top of your hooped fabric and stitch according to your machine instructions. Once stitching is complete you can tear off the remaining mylar.



Step 2 - Assembling the Embroidery Pocket

Fold 18" x 12" inch strip in half with wrong sides together. Embroidery designs will be on top. Insert the 18" x 6" quilt batting in center making a sandwich.

Cut binding fat quarter into 2.5" strips and bind pocket piece across 18" top edge only.

Step 3 - Assembling the Caddy

Sandwich together front, batting and back fat quarter. Use a spray adhesive to hold the pieces together for quilting or pin in place.

Quilt with any pattern that you desire.

Place the embroidered pocket on top of caddy piece at the bottom and pin in place.

Use your markings on the pocket to stitch a straight line from top of pocket to bottom of pocket. Be as creative as you want to be. You can ad pockets with decorative stitches in any location or size that you want.

Attach your binding and sew in place.
