Tension, Threads and overall use will be covered in the **Longarm 101 class**. We highly recommend that new & non owners register for this class as well.

Fast, Fun and Fabulous Free Motion Quilting - Free motion quilting is easier than you think! Create flowing designs by connecting simple elements with continuous lines, traveling across the quilt or filling in a specific area. Learn how drawing and muscle memory contribute to beautiful free motion quilting and how to create stunning designs. TOPICS INCLUDE: How to develop an inventory of free motion designs • Proper scaling and spacing of design elements • Edge to edge free motion quilting • Adjusting your quilting path to create your own new designs • Using Micro Handles for free-motion control

Ruler Essentials - If you love precision & consistency in your quilting designs, you will love using design rulers & templates! These handy tools assist in placing designs accurately & stitching them out precisely. The wide variety of Handi Quilter rulers will inspire you to new design heights. TOPICS INCLUDE: Handling rulers safely • Understand and use ruler markings for precision and accuracy • Use piecing lines and marking tools to build ruler design confidence • VersaTool quilting: stitch-in-the-ditch, cross-hatch, piano keys, clamshells and arcs • Apply binding with the HQ VersaTool

Creative Textures and Fills - Limitless creative design elements await you instead of simple meandering. Expand your design portfolio by learning the stitch path of a wide variety of filler designs. You'll even learn which designs best lend themselves to micro-quilting and how to use MicroHandles for best results. -- Selecting appropriate fills to complement design styles • Create special effects with different fillers • Scale the fill design size appropriately.

The 3 "B's" - Background, Borders & Block -- The 3Bs are the basic components of many pieced quilt tops and there are tricks to quilting them with a cohesive overall look while creating your own personal style. Learn how to select & adapt designs to complement each area and how to accomplish the quilting efficiently and easily. TOPICS INCLUDE: Creating a step-by-step plan for custom quilting your quilt • Adapt block designs for borders and sashings • How to handle quilting spaces wider than the frame • How to create background fills and when to use them • How to audition, resize and adapt quilting designs.

Feather Foundations - Feather designs always add a touch of class to any quilt. Learn to draw and stitch these beautiful elements in many different styles, from traditional to contemporary. TOPICS INCLUDE: Basic feather spines and stitching paths • Feathered wreaths and swags • Fitting feathers within a geometric space • Feathered borders • Using feathers in an overall design.

Quilting Beyond the Design - This "wrap-up" session is designed as an opportunity for you to apply what you've learned to your own quilt. Each student will have the opportunity to audition possible quilting designs on one of their own quilt top. With guidance from instructors and input from other students this is one of students favorite experiences. This class will also allow you additional hands-on quilting time with rulers and accessories.
