This HANDS ON 3-day comprehensive workshop consists of two classes per day focusing on FREE MOTION QUILTING. It is not designed as an intro to longarm quilting. Tension, threads and overall use will be covered in the LONGARM 101 class. We highly recommend that new and non-owners register for that class as well.

FAST, FUN & FABULOUS FREE MOTION QUILTING: Create flowing designs by connecting simple elements with continuous lines. Learn how drawing and muscle memory contribute to beautiful free motion quilting. **TOPICS INCLUDE:** Developing an inventory of free motion designs • Proper scaling and spacing of elements • Edge-to-edge quilting • Use of Micro Handles for free-motion control •

RULER ESSENTIALS: If you love precision and consistency in your quilting designs, you will love using rulers to assist in placing designs accurately and stitching them out precisely. **TOPICS INCLUDE:** Handling rulers safely; Understanding and using ruler markings • Using piecing lines and marking tools to build designs • Uses for VersaTool: stitch-in-the-ditch, cross-hatch, piano keys, clamshells, arcs • Applying binding with the HQ VersaTool •

CREATIVE TEXTURES & FILLS: Expand beyond simple meandering and create a design portfolio by learning stitch paths of a wide variety of filler designs. **TOPICS INCLUDE:** Which designs are best for micro-quilting • Selecting appropriate fills to complement design styles • Creating special effects with different fillers • Scaling the fill design size appropriately •

THE 3 Bs - Background, Borders & Block: The 3 B's are the basic components of many pieced quilt tops. There are tricks to quilting with a cohesive overall look while creating your own style. Learn how to select and adapt designs to complement each area and quilt efficiently and easily. **TOPICS INCLUDE:** Step-by-step plan for custom quilting • Adapting block designs for borders and sashings • Quilting spaces wider than the frame • Creating background fills • Auditioning, resizing, and adapting designs •

FEATHER FOUNDATIONS: Feather designs always add a touch of class to any quilt. Learn to draw and stitch these beautiful elements in many different styles. **TOPICS INCLUDE:** Basic feather spines and stitching paths • Feathered wreaths and swags • Fitting feathers within a geometric space • Feathered borders •

QUILTING BEYOND THE DESIGN: This wrap-up session is designed as an opportunity for you to apply what you've learned to your own quilt. Each student will have the opportunity to audition possible designs on one of their own quilt tops. With guidelines from instructors and input from other students, this is one of the students' most favorite experiences.
