BASIC SKILLS CLASSES

BASIC ROTARY SKILLS * DANA BRABSON (*This class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for all machine classes.*) Begin your quilting experience with patches that are exactly the right size. In this class, we introduce you to the wide spectrum of rotary cutters, rulers and mats that are available, and to the techniques that enable you to cut fabric patches with accuracy and precision. Complete the class, and receive a \$10 credit for any store purchase. 2 hrs: \$24.00.

***BEGINNING QUILTING PT. 1 – ROTARY CUTTING * VANESSA HALE** Begin your quilting journey with pieces that are exactly the right size. In this class, we introduce you to the world of rotary cutters, rulers and mats, and to the techniques that enable you to cut fabric pieces with accuracy and precision. 2 hrs: \$24.00.

BEGINNING QUILTING PT. 2 – INTRODUCTION TO PIECING * VANESSA HALE This basic class introduces you to machine piecing techniques and gives you the experience to continue in your quilt making journey. Pt. 1 – Rotary Cutting is a preferred prerequisite to Introduction to Piecing.

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LET'S GET STARTED * DANA BRABSON (*This class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for all machine classes.*) Not sure about the "quilter's scant quarter inch" seam allowance? Need to know about "nesting seams"? Let's get started! This course takes you from the Basic Rotary Skills class to the Introduction to Machine Piecing class. We'll also learn about the quarter inch foot, the walking foot, and about the fabrics, threads, and batting that are best for your quilting project. Note: You must bring your own sewing machine to this class. 2½ hrs: \$30.00.

INTRODUCTION TO MACHINE PIECING * DANA BRABSON This basic class introduces you to machine piecing techniques and gives you the experience you need to take any other *Quilt Works* class. You make a different block in each of the first 4 classes, and then quilt and bind a placemat in the 5th class. The placemats are $18" \times 12"$. If you choose to create a table runner with the 4 blocks, it is $63" \times 18"$. A wall hanging with the 4 blocks finishes at $33" \times 33"$, and can be used as a nice table topper. *The "Let's Get Started" class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for this class.* 10 hrs: \$120.00. Beginning Machine Quilting I is a prerequisite for this class. Becky will demonstrate the use of templates, marking, and quilting without marking. Specialty threads will also be discussed.

BINDING BASICS ** DANA BRABSON Your project is quilted and needs a binding. Learn how to apply a binding by machine. It is OK to wear masks in the Shop. We continue to provide curbside delivery. We are ready to ship orders to your destination.

REWARDS FOR SHOPPING AT THE QUILT WORKS AND AT QUILTS OLÉ:

With the joining of The Quilt Works and Quilts Olé, the Rewards system in place at The Quilt Works now applies to purchases made at Quilts Olé. DISCOUNTS AND OTHER INCENTIVES:

MILITARY DISCOUNTS: To express our appreciation to those who have served or are serving our country in the US armed forces (including the National Guard and the reserves), we offer a 10% discount to the member and his/her dependents on all full-price merchandise.

BIRTHDAY DISCOUNTS: Be sure to shop on your birthday: You will receive a 25% discount on all full price merchandise purchased on that day. (Special arrangements will be made if your birthday falls on a day when the shop is closed.)

STUDENT DISCOUNT COUPON: As an additional incentive to take classes at *The Quilt Works*, we offer Student Discount Coupons. This Coupon entitles you to a one-time 20% discount on full-priced merchandise, and is valid for 30 days. You will receive this Coupon at the first class meeting. (*Basic Rotary Skills* and visiting instructor classes are excluded.)

CLASS POLICIES: Payment in full is required to reserve a seat in the class. You may register in person or by phone using a credit card; the total class fee is due at the time of registration.

Although we HATE to cancel classes, sometimes it is inevitable. The shops reserve the right to cancel a class and will attempt to reschedule. If a class cannot be rescheduled, a refund will be given.
