INFORMATION ABOUT OUR CLASSES

Descriptive information for all of our classes, along with dates and times, is included in this Newsletter. The same information, along with pictures of the Class Models, can be found on our website. The dropdown CLASSES menu at the top of our Home page will take you to 3 pages: BASIC SKILLS CLASSES, FAVORITE CLASSES, and NEW CLASSES.

If you are new to quilting or want to sharpen some of your skills, we encourage you to go to our BASIC SKILLS CLASSES page. Our FAVORITE CLASSES have been offered before (in some cases, over and over!). The classes on our NEW CLASSES page are being offered for the first time in our shop (or offered again after a long hiatus).

CLASS POLICIES

You may register in person, on line, or by phone using a credit card; the total class fee is due at time of registration. Class fees are non-refundable unless the class is cancelled by *The Quilt Works, Inc.*, or you notify us five (5) days in advance of the class.

PLEASE REVIEW YOUR CLASS SUPPLY LIST AND THE BASIC SEWING SUPPLY LIST. Be prepared to have fun in your class by having all your supplies.

If you miss a class, a makeup is available for \$20/hour.

Private lessons are \$20/hour.

Sewing machines may be rented for Classes and Sew-Ins for \$10/day.

Skill Levels: * Beginner, no experience needed. ** Rotary skills and machine piecing experience are required. *** Advanced skills needed.

BASICS, BASICS, BASICS

BASIC ROTARY SKILLS * DANA BRABSON (*This class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for all machine classes.*) Begin your quilting experience with patches that are exactly the right size. In this class, we introduce you to the wide spectrum of rotary cutters, rulers and mats that are available, and to the techniques that enable you to cut fabric patches with accuracy and precision. Complete the class, and receive a \$10 credit for any store purchase. 2 hrs: \$24.00.

Wednesday, January 17 1:00-3:00 or 5:30-7:30.

Saturday, March 30 10:00-12:00.

LET'S GET STARTED * DANA BRABSON (*This class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for all machine classes.*) Not sure about the "quilter's scant quarter inch" seam allowance? Need to know about "nesting seams"? Let's get started! This course takes you from the Basic Rotary Skills class to the Introduction to Machine Piecing class. We'll also learn about the quarter inch foot, the walking foot, and about the fabrics, threads, and batting that are best for your quilting project. Note: You must bring your own sewing machine to this class. 2½ hrs: \$30.00.

Wednesday, January 24 1:00-3:30 or 5:30-8:00.

INTRODUCTION TO MACHINE PIECING * DANA BRABSON This basic class introduces you to machine piecing techniques and gives you the experience you need to take any other *Quilt Works* class. You make a different block in each of the first 4 classes, and then quilt and bind a placemat in the 5th class. The placemats are 18" × 12". If you choose to create a table runner with the 4 blocks, it is 63" × 18". A wall hanging with the 4 blocks finishes at 33" × 33", and can be used as a nice table topper. *The "Let's Get Started" class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for this class*.

10 hrs: \$120.00. (NOTE: No classes February 14, 21, 28.)

Wednesdays, January 31, February 7, March 6, 13, 20 1:00-3:00 or 5:30-7:30.

BEGINNING HAND APPLIQUÉ SAMPLER * KATHI DINEEN The sampler quilt teaches you many different techniques starting with the easiest and building on what you have learned from each class. Whether you are a beginner or have lots of experience you'll love this wall size project.

7 hrs: \$84.00.

Sunday, January 21 1:00-4:00 Sundays, February 18 and March 17 1:00-3:00.

BEGINNING MACHINE APPLIQUÉ * BECKY WELCH Learn basic appliqué techniques and tips to enhance your projects.

3 hrs: \$46.00 (Class fee, \$36.00 + kit fee, \$10.00).

Friday, January 26 1:00-4:00.

BEGINNING MACHINE QUILTING I * BECKY WELCH You must bring your own machine, its walking foot, and its free motion or darning foot. Your top is finished and now it's time to bring it to life with the quilting. Becky will show many techniques, threads and tricks to enhance your quilting skills.

3 hrs: \$52.00 (Class fee, \$36.00 + kit fee, \$16.00).

Friday, February 23 1:00-4:00.

BEGINNING MACHINE QUILTING II ** **BECKY WELCH** Your own machine with a darning foot is required for this class where you will learn the art of free motion quilting. Beginning Machine Quilting I is a prerequisite for this class. Becky will demonstrate the use of templates, marking, and quilting without marking. Specialty threads will also be discussed.

3 hrs: \$36.00.

Friday, March 22 1:00-4:00.

BINDING BASICS ** DANA BRABSON Your project is quilted and needs a binding. Learn how to apply a binding by machine. We apply the binding to curved edges, create faux-mitered corners, and join the binding strips so that the joints are virtually bump-free. Then we add both a wide binding and a binding with a flange to our practice piece, and even learn how to apply a binding to the edge of a quilt with 90-degree notches around the edge.

CUSTOM COTTON & LEATHER STITCH CASE ** KERI PAYNE This charming stitching case will hold your notions in style. It is finished with a custom laser engraved leather motif to make it truly unique. Keri will guide you through this fun project.

LIGHT THE WAY WITH COLOR ** **MICHELLE JACKSON** Everyone has that favorite photo of a place that has special memories and gives you a certain feeling. I will help you transform that photo into a beautiful original art quilt overflowing with color and value that will move the viewer. All levels will benefit from this workshop.

ALASKA ** CAROL MEINCKE This lovely quilt is dramatic and beautiful, just like the land it's named after. The precision required is achieved by paper piecing. Carol teaches a freezer paper method that eliminates tearing away paper later. 6 hrs: \$72.00.

COLOR CONFIDENCE * DANA BRABSON AND BECKY WELCH Gain confidence choosing fabrics for your quilts! Small projects teach value, contrast, and easy ways to incorporate "sparkle." Successive classes will build on your experiences and observations of your classmates' work.

9 hrs: \$108.00.

Saturdays, January 27, February 24, March 23 1:00-4:00

FRQ (FREE RANGE QUILTERS) *** BECKY WELCH Free range quilting – thinking "outside the box." Our project for this quarter will be to create an original small art quilt as a tribute to a special person. In January we will explore each student's ideas and possible techniques needed. February's class will further this with hands on technique instruction, and we will wrap up/catch up our project in March.

Three 3-hr sessions: \$36.00/session.

HAND APPLIQUÉ-TION ** KATHI DINEEN Join us as we continue to explore the richness and depth of hand appliqué techniques, materials, notions, and designs in quilting. Almost nothing is out of bounds: fabrics such as linens and wool. threads that are variegated in color and heavier than usual, reverse as well as "ordinary" appliqué, and "sew" on. We shall have something different each month as we explore the edges of our comfort zones.

Three, 2-hr sessions: \$24.00/session. Saturday, January 13 10:00-12:00. Saturday, February 10 10:00-12:00. Saturday, March 9 10:00-12:00.

SANTA ANA WINDS *** DANA BRABSON This design spins with the wind. The curves are gentle and easy to piece, since the block is trimmed to the correct size after sewing. You'll be able to create your own design once your blocks are completed.

This is an A to Z technique class in which we imagine the design of the finished quilt, practice methods for stabilizing the T-shirt fabrics, explore the juncture between stabilized T-shirts and other fabrics, examine quilting ideas, and much more.

WILD ONION ** BECKY WELCH Asymmetrical curves create dynamic movement in this quilt. Explore different layouts with this block. The Ovals All Ways slotted ruler makes cutting the curves easy. Give curved piecing a try! 6 hrs: \$72.00.

CERTIFIED SHOP: The Quilt Works is now a Judy Niemeyer Certified shop and authorized to teach all of the Quiltworx.com, Judy Niemeyer Quilting patterns.

REMAINING COVID-19 CONCERNS:

It is not required that individuals wear masks while in the Shop. However, if you feel uncomfortable in this environment, we shall continue to support you in every possible way. It is OK to wear masks in the Shop. We continue to provide curbside delivery. We are ready to ship orders to your destination.

Remember that there are hand sanitizers dispensers by both doors.

REWARDS FOR SHOPPING AT THE QUILT WORKS AND AT QUILTS OLÉ:

With the joining of The Quilt Works and Quilts Olé, the Rewards system in place at The Quilt Works now applies to purchases made at Quilts Olé. Add the Rewards points accumulated at Quilts Olé to those gotten at The Quilt Works; when the total is 250, your account is credited with \$25.00 that you may spend on a future transaction at either shop.

DISCOUNTS AND OTHER INCENTIVES:

MILITARY DISCOUNTS: To express our appreciation to those who have served or are serving our country in the US armed forces (including the National Guard and the reserves), we offer a 10% discount to the member and his/her dependents on all full-price merchandise.

BIRTHDAY DISCOUNTS: Be sure to shop on your birthday: You will receive a 25% discount on all full price merchandise purchased on that day. (Special arrangements will be made if your birthday falls on a day when the shop is closed.)

STUDENT DISCOUNT COUPON: As an additional incentive to take classes at *The Quilt Works*, we offer Student Discount Coupons. This Coupon entitles you to a one-time 20% discount on full-priced merchandise, and is valid for 30 days. You will receive this Coupon at the first class meeting. (*Basic Rotary Skills* and visiting instructor classes are excluded.)

SENIOR DISCOUNT DAY: Each Tuesday is a "Senior Discount Day". Your senior discount (for those 60 and older) is 10%.

"WE'VE GOT YOUR BACK" DISCOUNT: Bring in and show us your finished quilt top, and we shall give you a 20% discount on the cost of full-priced fabric for the back.

END OF BOLT DISCOUNT: If you take all of the full priced fabric that remains on a bolt, regardless of the amount, your discount is 10%.

FAT QUARTERS PURCHASE: When you purchase 10 Fat Quarters in a single purchase, you receive an eleventh Fat Quarter at no additional cost.

FAT EIGHTHS PURCHASE: When you purchase 4 Fat Eighths in a single purchase, you receive a fifth Fat Eighth at no additional cost.

GIFT CARDS:

They are great presents, and can be purchased at the front desk and on-line. For cards purchased at the shop, you may choose any value for the card. Gift Cards purchased on-line are available in five values (only): \$25, \$50, \$75, \$100, and \$150.
