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# BERRY PATCH FABRICS & BERNINA LONGARM

**We have four Bernina Longarm options for you!**

Our Longarm is available to rent by the hour. It is available with and without our Qmatic computerized quilting system. We do require you to complete our three hour training course for free-motion quilting and our 3 hour Qmatic course, if you choose that option. More details are below –

1. Hourly Free Motion rentals require that you complete our three hour, one-on-one free motion course. The course includes cleaning, oiling, threading, and loading bobbins, and loading the quilt, etc. You will also get a “zippered leader” set for use on your future rentals. Practice time is included and ruler work will be covered, if time permits. You will receive two hours at no charge if you rent within two weeks of your training. This preparation course is \$150.00. Future Free Motion Rentals are \$25 per hour.
2. If you choose the Qmatic option, you will take our 3 hour, one-on-one course on the use of the automated system. A prerequisite for this course is that you must have completed your two free hours of free hand quilting work to reinforce your skills. You will learn to use the Qmatic to design and sew our edge-to-edge quilt, boundaries, markers, drop-in, and other techniques, if time permits. This training course is \$75. The Qmatic rental with the Longarm system is \$25 per hour. This option is a two hour minimum.
3. We also offer rental for our “sit down” Bernina Q16. The training course is one hour of one-on-one training to become familiar with the Q16. Cost is \$25. This includes practice time. Rentals afterward are \$10 per hour.
4. All Bernina Longarm products are available for sale at the Berry Patch. We would be pleased to discuss any prices and other purchase details. Long term training and support is included.

## BERNINA FINANCING

Flexible plans are available with Bernina Charge. “No Interest” plans are available for different length time periods. We are sure there will be one just right for you. Sign-up is easy if you do not already have a Bernina Charge. You can access [bernina.com](http://bernina.com) and sign-up online or we can sign you up in the store. This takes about 5 minutes, and you are ready to go. If you apply online, just print off the approval number and bring it with you when you visit the store.

We are happy to accept your check, other credit cards and of course, we still gladly accept cash. Financing plans change often, so be sure to check with us often.

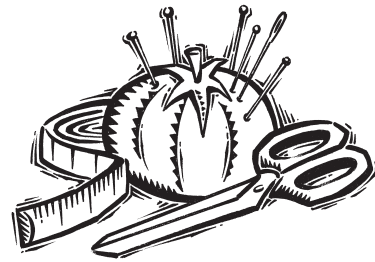
## Shirley's Recipe Corner

This is an easy, yummy recipe for a crab dip. I served it at our BP Christmas party and it was a hit!

### HOT CRAB DIP

- 1 8 oz package cream cheese
- 1/2 cup mayo
- 1/2 sour cream
- 1/2 cup shredded Parmesan cheese
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 pound lump crab meat
- 1 Tbls lemon juice
- 1 tsp hot sauce
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1/4 black pepper
- 1/4 shredded Parmesan cheese, for topping
- 1 Tbls sliced green onion for topping

1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees
2. In a large bowl mix together cream cheese, mayo, and sour cream. Stir in parmesan cheese, cheddar cheese, lemon juice, hot sauce, salt and pepper until well combined. Fold in crab meat.
3. Pour into a 1 quart baking dish. Sprinkle with remaining parmesan cheese.
4. Bake for 25-35 minutes until bubbly and hot.
5. Remove from the oven and top with green onions. Enjoy!

# SCHEDULE OF CURRENT SEWING CLASSES

Many classes have kits that are required and we have tried to keep their expense to a minimum. Many classes do not require a kit, but do require supplies. We ask that you purchase the class supplies from the Berry Patch. This is the only way we can maintain low class fees.

Our classes are presented for the individual use of those attending. If you teach somewhere else or plan to do so, please let us know. We have different class fees when we train teachers.

Most classes fill quickly, so we suggest you register early to reserve your spot! Whenever there is a question about you participating in a class, don't hesitate to discuss it with us. We try to accommodate everyone if possible.

 This symbol represents classes that require you bring your sewing machine.

 This symbol represents classes that specialize in handwork.

**Skill Level I** - Some sewing experience will be helpful. Basic use of your sewing machine may be required. Some Skill Level I classes are true beginner's classes and you start from the very beginning.

**Skill Level II** - These are not basic sewing classes, so you will need a background...perhaps the basic classes or experience in other areas of sewing. When machines are required, you should be familiar with the functions of your specific model of machine.

We believe that our class schedule is an important part of the service we provide. Our teachers and staff work hard to provide quality training in many areas and we appreciate your participation.

We ask that you sign up for the classes you wish to take as soon as you decide, rather than wait to see if the class makes with the minimum three students. This will help us with scheduling.

Finally, we ask that you call us if you have signed up and paid for a class, but are unable to attend. If you call us three days before the class date, we will be happy to refund your fee. This happens often and the class space is unused. Many of the classes have a waiting list of students that would like to attend. Thanks for your understanding!
