

# Cappuccino Party for 4 Workshop

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- I. Cappuccino Party for 4 was designed to take advantage of the 2 ½ inch strips. This one day workshop will enhance your foundation paper piecing and traditional piecing skills. You will learn a simple concept using two strips of fabric to create one appealing block design. The quilt was designed as a fun and fast project for most skill levels and is very fast to complete.

- III. Please read through the pattern a time or two before class.
- IV. Techniques used: Cutting and preparing foundation papers; paper piecing tutorial; floating points; paper piecing template; tools for paper pieced quilting;
- V. **Optional: Prepare Instructions**
  - a. Cut pages down the middle to fit into the sheet protectors
  - b. Place in ½” to 1” binder
  - c. This makes it easier to flip through and/or take notes

## Pre-Class Instructions:

- VI. Mark your (4) large Ziploc bags as follows:
  - a. Bag #1 – Unit J
  - b. Bag #2 – Unit K
  - c. Bag #3 – Unit L
  - d. Bag #4 – Sashing / Binding
- VII. **Cutting & Organizing the Newsprint Sheets (there are (3) NP 353 sheets)**
  - a. Cut ALL UNIT J, K & L foundation papers approximately 1/8” outside the solid black line of each UNIT J, K & L – there are 6 each
    - i. Clip (6) UNIT J together – place in Bag #1
    - ii. Clip (6) UNIT K together – place in Bag #2
    - iii. Clip (6) UNIT L together – place in Bag #3

- b. Cut STRIP TEMPLATE on outer solid black line
  - i. Place (1) in each of Bag #1, Bag #2, & Bag #3
- c. Cut GRID TEMPLATE on outer solid black line
  - i. Place in Bag #4

VIII. Pre-cutting & Organizing your fabric

- a. Sashing fabric – 5/8 yard (this is used to join the Units-see cover sample)
  - i. Cut (13) 1-1/4" x 42" strips – Place in Bag #4
  - ii. Cut (2) 2-1/2" x 42" strips – sub-cut each into (3) 2-1/2" x 14" strips
    - 1. Clip the (6) 2-1/2" x 14" strips together – Place in Bag #2
- b. (36) 2-1/2" x 42" strips
  - i. Pair (1) lighter with (1) darker strip for total of (18) pairs
    - 1. Divide the (18) pairs into (3) stacks of (6) pairs each
      - a. Place one stack into each of Bag #1, Bag #2 & Bag #3

IX. Be sure to bring ALL BAGS to class

X. Be sure to bring your INSTRUCTIONS to class
