

Hoffman Crackers Class Supply List

Basic Paper Piecing Supplies:

Sewing Machine in good working order (you need to know how to operate your machine)

- ¼" piecing foot (this foot is used for assembly)
- Regular or open-toe foot (we will paper piece with this foot)
- Machine accessories – power cord, foot control, bobbins, etc

Size 70/10 or 75/11 Microtex Sharp sewing machine needles (Schmetz recommended)

Good quality thread for piecing (I use Aurifil 50 wt-neutral color light gray or cream or similar)

Pre-wind 1-2 bobbins prior to class (use above mentioned thread)

Optional: Small iron and pressing mat (personal use)

Rotary cutter w/new blade inserted – 60mm (recommended) or 45mm

Personal cutting mat - 18"x24" (preferred) or 12"x18"

6"x12" or 6"x24" rotary cutting ruler

Add-A-Quarter ruler(s) – 12" (recommended starting size)

Folding template (I recommend cutting one from quilters template plastic about 3" x 12")

Scissors

Thread snips

Seam ripper (I like the Tuck Away Seam Ripper)

Purple Thang

Glue pen – water soluble (SewLine) & refills (my favorite notion)

UHU washable glue stick (or similar)

Quilting pins (long and thin)

And any other favorite basic sewing supplies

Pattern, Fabric & other supplies:

Hoffman Crackers Pattern by Judy Niemeyer

Fabrics – (40) 10" squares (layer cake); if using yardage, have fabric precut to (40) 10" squares (you will need (20) light to medium squares and (20) medium to dark squares)

(4) Large Ziplock bags – gallon size

Large silver paper clips – box of 100 (these are important)

Scotch Tape

Black Sharpie & Pencil

Small sticky notes
