

To make the quilt pictured:



You need:


- 4 yards of various greens to be cut into 1.5" strips for blocks + green border
- 6½ yards of off white
- ¾ yard of a single green for binding

Note: this quilt is made up of 1 - 8" finished block which looks like this:



Note: When sewing this quilt top, use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams. When cutting and a long strip is called for, sew together strips til you get the length needed.

<u>Cut:</u> (for one block) This quilt used 80 blocks. Total number needed for this quilt in parenthesis ()



For block:

• From various greens: (you need 80 of each piece in order to make 80 blocks)

1 - 1.5" x 1.5" square

1 - 1.5"x 2.5"

1-1.5"x 3.5"

1-1.5"x 4.5"

1 – 1.5"x 5.5"

1 – 1.5"x 6.5"

1 – 1.5"x 7.5"

1 – 1.5" x8.5"

• White or cream: (you need 80 of each piece in order to make 80 blocks)

1 - 1.5" x 1.5" square

1 – 1.5"x 2.5"

1-1.5"x 3.5"

1 - 1.5"x 4.5"

1-1.5"x 5.5"

1-1.5"x 6.5"

1 – 1.5"x 7.5"

Note – because mine was scrappy and from second-hand materials, I tended to cut some and then make the blocks and cut some more – a few times - because cutting this many pieces from random shaped pieces of fabric is so tedious.

For sashings/cornerstones:

• From white or cream:

40 - 1.5"x 8.5"


35 - 1.5"x 17.5"


4 - 1.5"x 71.5"

Borders will be discussed later.

Construct blocks:

Using this layout, make your blocks as shown by sewing together as shown – they are numbered.






sew together as numbered:

I'll show you the first couple of steps. After that continue in the same way by adding as numbered and using the colors shown (green or white).

Sew together two squares green/white (1.5")




Next – add the green 1.5"x 2.5" strip to the top as shown:



Now add a white 1.5"x 2.5" to the left side as shown:




Add a white 1.5"x 3.5" white to the top of this as shown:



Now keep adding to the left and top as these last two rounds until the block is

8.5"x8.5".



Make 80. Mine are all different. They should measure 8.5"x8.5" at this point.

How to put together this quilt:

1. Sew together in rows and create center.

First take units as shown in groups of two and put them together with a 1.5"x 8.5" sashing strip in between each block in the direction as shown:




Make up ALL of the blocks like this. You will have 40 of these.

Now make a big block like this


Using a 1.5"x 17.5" strip between the goup you just made, put together a single block like this:



Now go through and put a 1.5"x 17.5" strip between each block and make 5 rows like this:



Now take a 1.5"x 71.5" white strip and put between each row and build your top as shown below (inside the white border) using all 5 of the rows you just created.



Once you have the center done, add borders.

2. Add borders.

A. Border 1 – white

Cut 2 - 4"x 89.5" - add to sides.

Cut 2-4" x 78.5" – add to top and bottom.

B. Border 2 – green

Cut 2 - 1.5"x 96.5" - add to sides.

Cut 2 - 1.5" x 80.5" – add to top and bottom.

- C. Border 3 white
 - Cut 2 3.5" x 98.5" add to sides.
 - Cut 2-4" x 86.5" add to top and bottom.
- D. Press well.
- E. Sandwich, using whatever type of batting and backing you prefer.
- F. **Quilt** as desired.
- G. **Bind**, using whatever method you wish.
