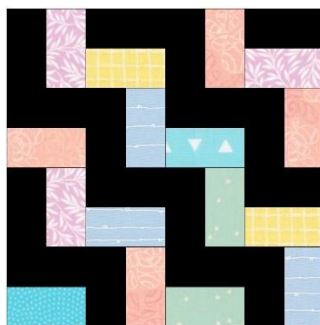


Mini 2-Rail Zigzag

88"x104"



This quilt is made up of one 8.5" block (8" finished) which looks like this:



To make the quilt pictured:

You need:

- 6 yards black
- 6 yards pastels
- ¾ yard various pastels to make into a binding – fully scrappy

Note: Make the top as big or small as you wish. I made mine 11x13 layout which makes a nice queen size quilt.

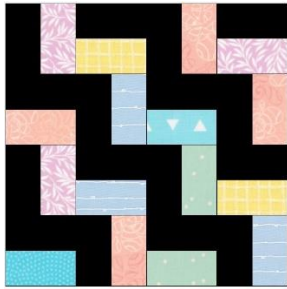
Cut:

For each rail fence block you need 16 of these units which will finish at 2"x2". At this point they are 2.5"x2.5".



Use a variety of pastels plus a black. These are made up of a 1.5"x2.5" strips individually. A variety will provide you with the most interesting quilt. Simply sew the black and pastel strip together to make the unit shown.

Construct blocks:



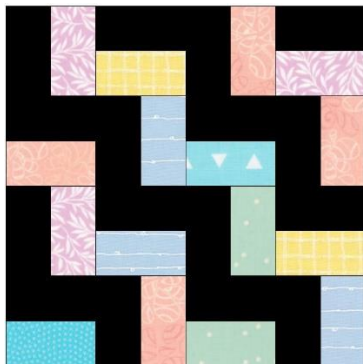
Sew in this order.

For each block, made these units: Change the direction of this little units until they look like this:



For each block, make 2 of each row. When finished, press all seams one direction.

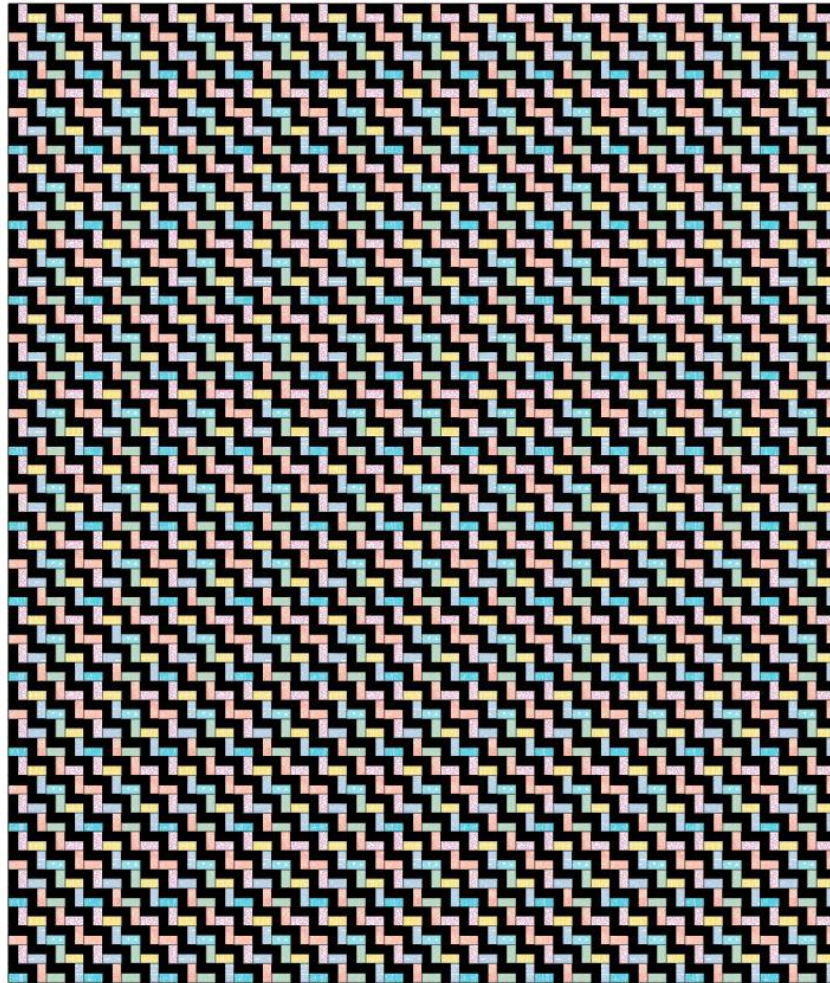
Make finished blocks.



For this quilt, make 143 blocks. Because this one is so labor intensive, I made a few rows at a time and then made more blocks and make more rows.

How to make this quilt:

1. **Construct your blocks as shown**
2. **Lay out completed blocks according to this diagram:**



3. **Sew together in rows.** Use this diagram to sew your blocks together to make a whole row.

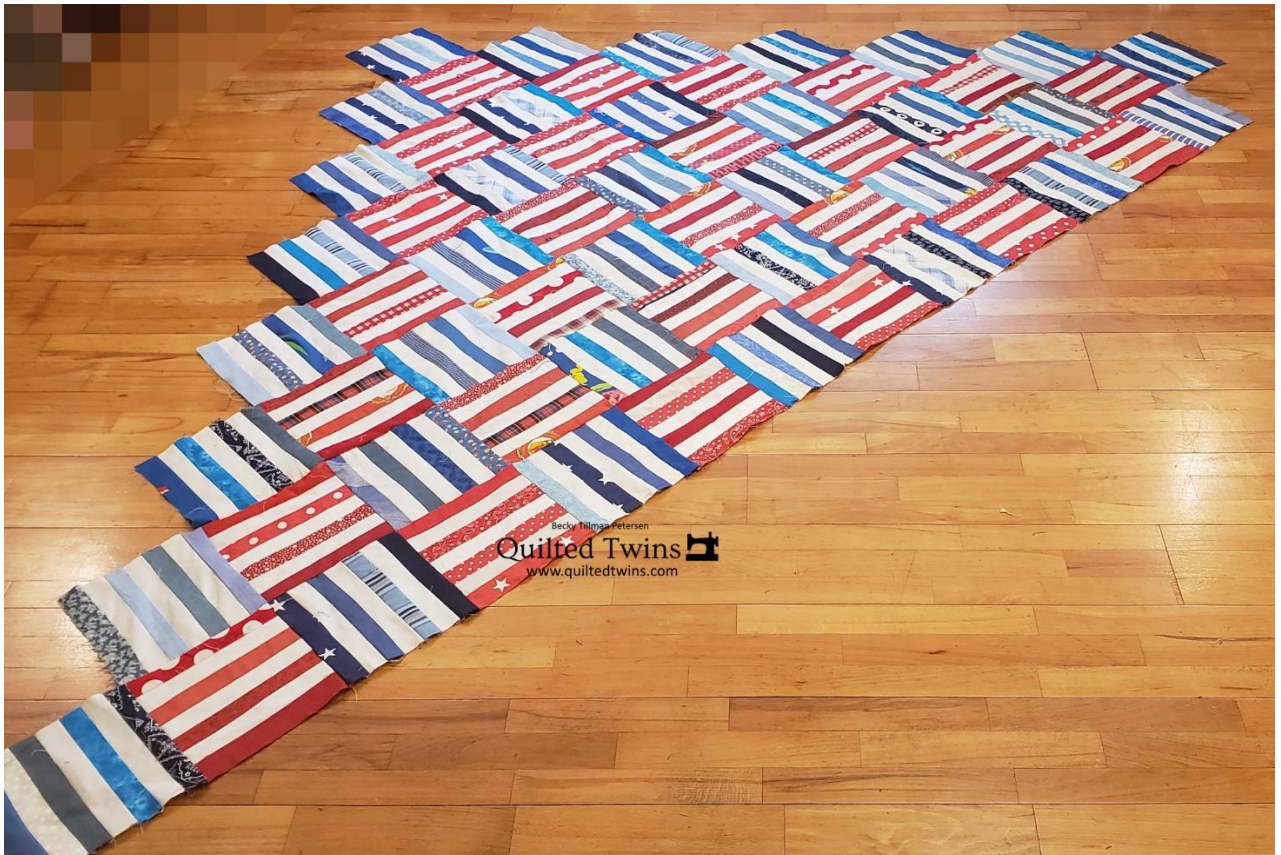


Make 13 of these rows.

4. **Press well.**
5. **Sandwich**, using whatever type of batting and backing you prefer
6. **Quilt** as desired.
7. **Bind**, using whatever method you wish.
