

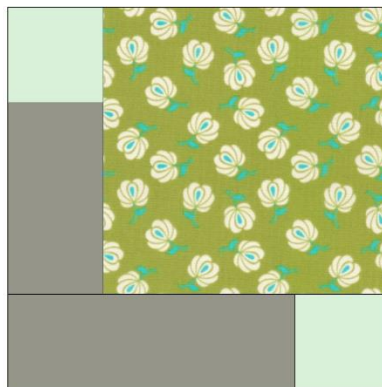
# Shadowed Florals

93"x104"

To make the quilt pictured:



This quilt is made up of one block – 8.5" (before sewing into the top) and looks like this:

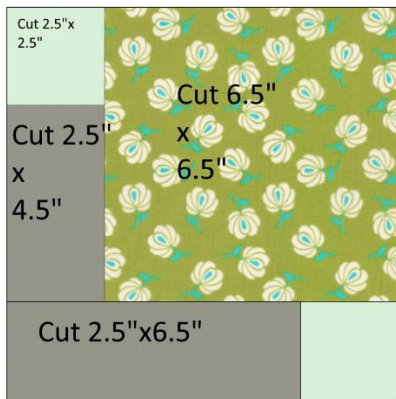


## You need:

- Enough floral scraps to cut 56 – 6.5” squares
- 1 3/4 yards of gray for the shadow and inner border
- 6 yards of light green
- 4 yards of darker green for border

## Cut:

### **For block:**



### **For EACH block cut these pieces: (this quilt uses 56 blocks – total in parenthesis)**

From lt. green:

- Cut 2 – 2½” squares (112)

From gray:

- Cut 1 – 2½”x 4½” (56)
- Cut 1 – 2½”x 6½” (56)

From various florals –

- Cut 1 – 6½” square (56)

### **For sashings:**

From light green:

- 64 – 3½” x 8½”
- 9 – 3½”x 80½” (piece as needed to get length mentioned)

### **Borders will be dealt with later under “How to make this quilt”**

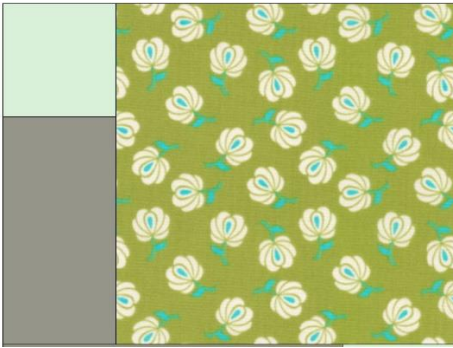
*Note: Any time a very long piece is required, sew multiple shorter pieces together to get length needed.*

## How to make this block:

Sew together a 2½” light green to a 2½” x 4½” gray strip like this:



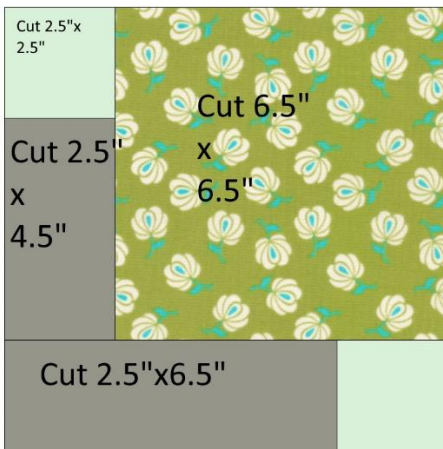
Attach to the square of fabric as shown below:



Now sew the 2½" light green square to the 2½" x 6½" gray strip like this:



Add it to the block as shown:



Now the block is 8½" x 8½". Make 56 blocks.

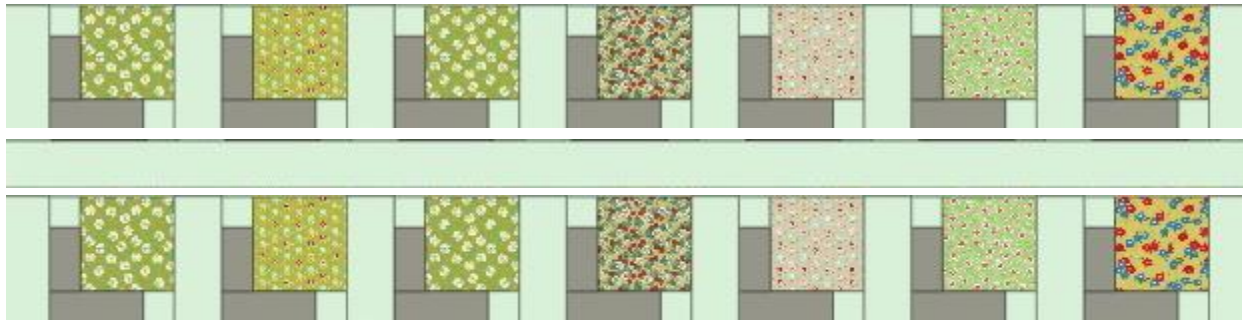
## How to put make this quilt:

1. Using this diagram for the center of the quilt, make your rows as shown below by adding a sashing strip of 3½" x 8½" between each block. Sew 7 in a row and put a sashing strip in front of the first one and after the last one as shown:

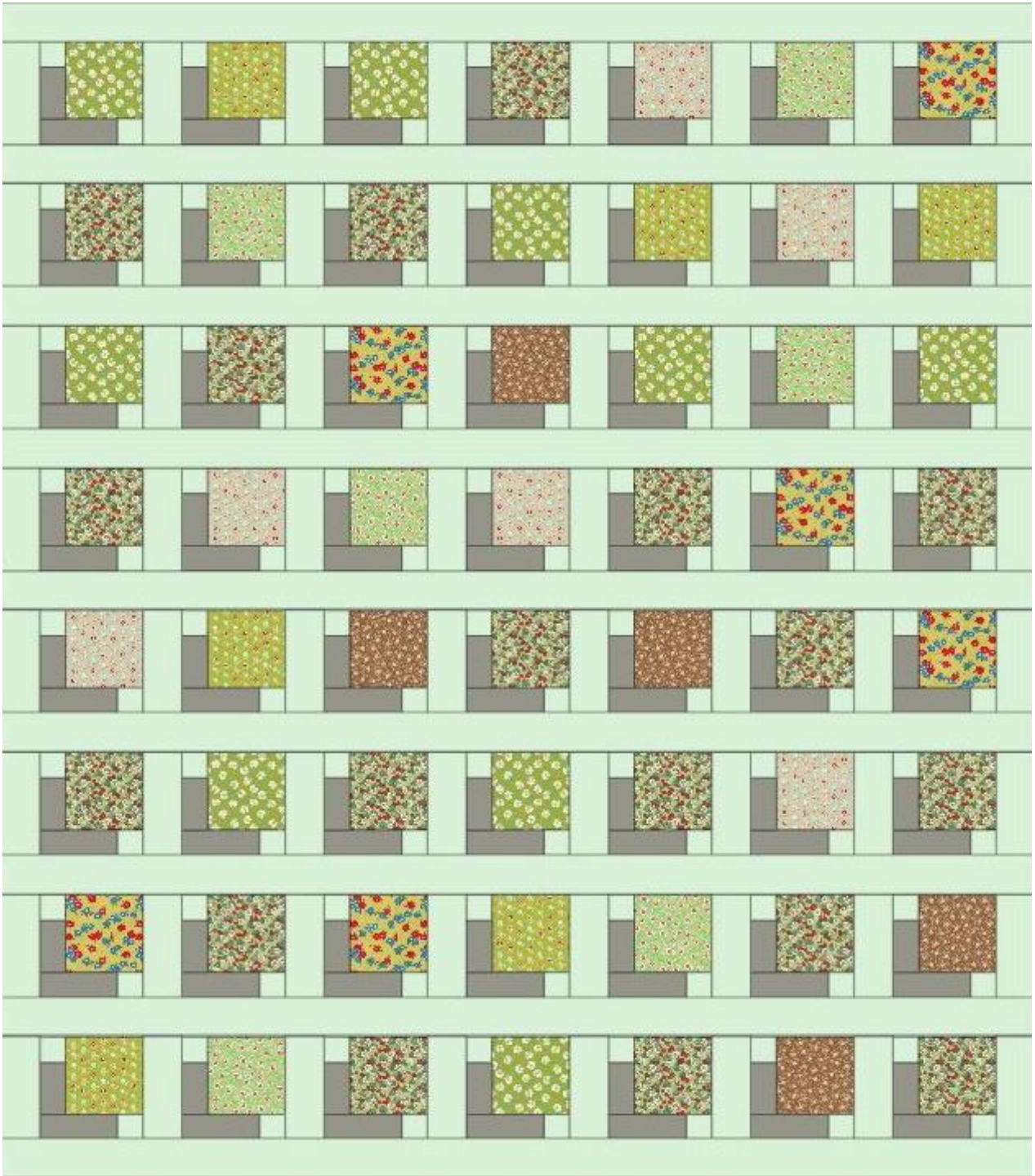


2. Make multiples of those.
3. Now add a long row of sashing cut 3½" x 80½" to these rows of sewn together blocks.



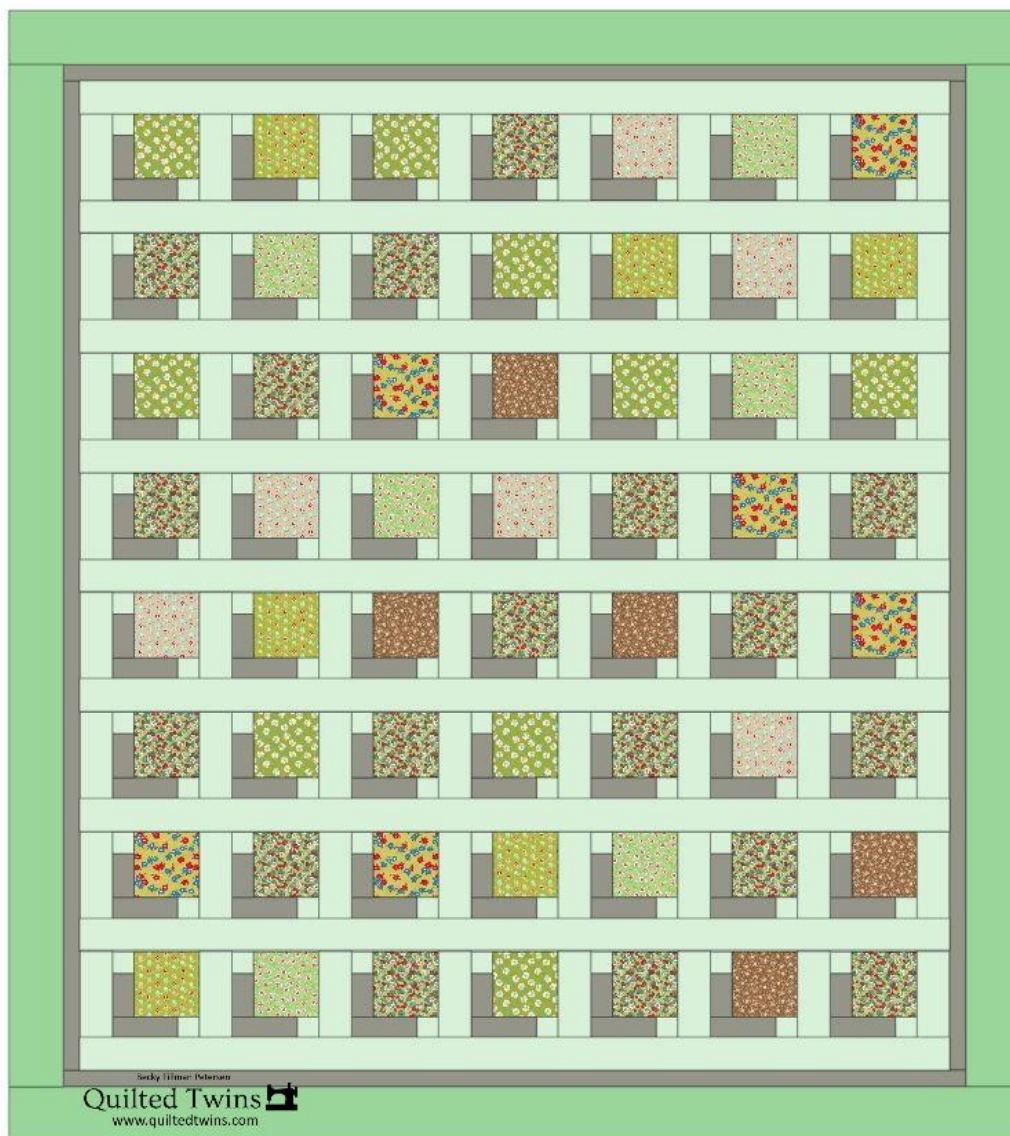


4. Keep sewing these together until the center looks like this: This is a 7x8 layout.



Once your rows are complete, now put them together as per the diagram above.

5. Add borders. Diagram is shown below:



A. First border: gray

- Cut 2 – 2" x 91½" – attach to the side of the center – piecing as necessary to get the needed length. Attach to sides.
- Cut 2 – 2" x 83½" piecing as necessary to get the needed length Attach to top and bottom.

B. Second border: darker green

- Cut 2 – 5½" x 94½" – Attach to sides.
- Cut 2 – 5½" x 93½" – Attach to top and bottom.

C. Press well.

D. Sandwich, using whatever type of batting and backing you prefer.

E. Quilt as desired.

F. Bind, using whatever method you wish.
