## Walkabout



This center of the quilt is made up of one block which is $20.5^{\prime \prime}$ before being sewn into the top:


To make the quilt pictured:

## You need:

- 3-7/8 yards of white
- 6-1/2 yards of various dark pastels
- About $3 / 4$ yards of fabric for the binding

Note: Use $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seams throughout. When long strips are needed, piece as needed to make length needed.

## Cut:

For each block: (make 20 blocks for this quilt)


From pastels -

- $72-2.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares

From white:

- 2 - $1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
- $2-1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$
- $2-1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$
- $2-1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 10.5^{\prime \prime}$
- $2-1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 14.5^{\prime \prime}$
- $2-1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 16.5^{\prime \prime}$


## For sashing: (for entire quilt as shown)

From white:
$15-1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 20.5^{\prime \prime}$
4-1.5"x83.5"
Final border will be covered later.

## Construct blocks:



I make these blocks from the center "out". As follows.

1. On each side of a $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ pastel square, sew your $1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$ white strips:

2. Add 1.5 " $x 4.5$ " white strips to the top and bottom.

3. Add a strip of two (2) 2.5 " pastel squares to each side of the center piece.

4. Add a strip of 4 (4) 2.5 " pastel squares to the top and bottom of the center piece.

5. Add white $1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$ strips to each side of the center.

6. Add white $1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 10.5^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom.

7. Add a strip of $5-2.5^{\prime \prime}$ pastel squares to each side.

8. Add a strip of $7-2.5^{\prime \prime}$ pastel squares to the top and bottom.

9. Add a 1.5 " $\times 14.5$ " white strip to each side of the center

10. Add a 1.5 " $\times 16.5^{\prime \prime}$ white strip to the top and bottom of the center.

11. Add a strip of $8-2.5^{\prime \prime}$ pastel squares to the sides of the center.

12. Add a strip of $102.5^{\prime \prime}$ pastel squares to the top and bottom.


At this point the block should be $20.5^{\prime \prime} \times 20.5^{\prime \prime}$. Make 20 to make a quilt the size of the original.

## How to put together this quilt:

1. Make blocks as described above.
2. Using this diagram, (for now, we are ignoring the outer border and tiny bit of binding which shows) lay out your rows.


Make your rows. Be sure to put a $1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 20.5^{\prime \prime}$ white sashing strip between the blocks as shown:


Make 5 rows as shown above.
3. Sew your rows together with a white $1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 83.5^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip.
4. Attach all those together so that the center is done - starting and stopping with a row of blocks.
5. Add border: There is only one border - it is white.

- For sides - Cut $2-1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 1041.5^{\prime \prime}$. Attach to the sides.
- For top and bottom - Cut $2-1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 85.5^{\prime \prime}$. Attach to the top and bottom.

6. Press well.
7. Sandwich, using whatever type of batting and backing you prefer
8. Quilt as desired. I used loops!
9. Bind, using whatever method you wish.
