## Fancy Squares

$100.5^{\prime \prime x} 100.5^{\prime \prime}$
To make the quilt pictured:


## You need:

- $31 / 4$ yards of black
- 1 yard of novelty fabric for center $5 x 5^{\prime \prime}$ squares (can use a charm pack - need 49
- $71 / 4$ yards of brights for the borders surrounding the 5 " $\times 5$ " square
- $1 / 2-5 / 8$ yard of fabric for the binding.

This quilt is made up of 1 block which finishes at $11.5^{\prime \prime}$ after being sewn into the quilt.

and
This quilt is made up of 49 blocks

## Cut:

## Make



- From bright for first round of the block: Cut in matched sets so that you can surround the block with one color:
2 -"2"x5" and 2-2"x8"
Then from a different bright:
$2-2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ and $2-2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ strips
$48-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$
- From novelty fabric (center of this block):

48 - 5 " $\times 5$ " squares

- From various colors - cut in sets for the outer ring of the block:

One of these sets for each block:
$21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8{ }^{1 / 2 \prime}$
$21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

For sashing:

- From black for sashing strips:

42-11/2"x12"
AND Piece $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times W O F$ strips to make
$6-1 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 87^{\prime \prime}$ for the long sashing strips that go between strips of blocks

## Borders will be discussed later:

## Construct blocks:

Make 49 of these blocks in a variety of colors.


From one fabric:
Add the $2 " x 5$ " two sides to the center block and then the $2 " x 8$ " strips to the top and bottom. Press.
Then from a different fabric:
Add the 2.5 " $\times 8^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the two sides of that block and then the $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom. Press.

## How to make this quilt:

1. Construct your blocks as shown above. Make 24 of each layout.

## 2. Place blocks as in this diagram.

3. Make 7 rows of blocks that are 7 blocks long:

Like this:


Put one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ black strip between each block. I alternated direction of my stripes for the center blocks.
4. Sew these all together


Add one of your sashing strips between these two rows of blocks: It now looks like this:


Keep going until the top center is finished.

5. Add the borders:

- First border - black border

Cut: (piece as necessary)
2-11/2"x87". Attach to the sides
$2-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 89 "$. Attach to the top and bottom.

- Second border - a piano key border using black and colorful 2"x5" pieces. Use 59 strips for each side.
- Cut 4 different 5"x5"colorful pieces.
- Cut a total of $\mathbf{1 2 0}$ black $\mathbf{2 " x}^{\prime \prime} \mathbf{x \prime}$ strips and $\mathbf{1 1 6}$ colorful ones.

Sew a total of 59 black and colorful strips together starting and ending with black ones - mixing up the colors as much you can. Make 4 of these.


- Make 2 like this with 59 strips and add to each side of the quilt top :
- Make 2 like this and add a 5"x5" square to each end. Attach to the top and bottom
- Third border - black

Cut: (piece as necessary)
2-2"x 98". Attach to the sides
2-2"x 101". Attach to the top and bottom.
Final layout:

6. Press well.
7. Sandwich, using whatever type of batting and backing you prefer
8. Quilt as desired. I did straight line quilting randomly spaced lines.
9. Bind, using whatever method you wish.
