

## Old World Fantasy Week 6:

Offering you clues in two color schemes –

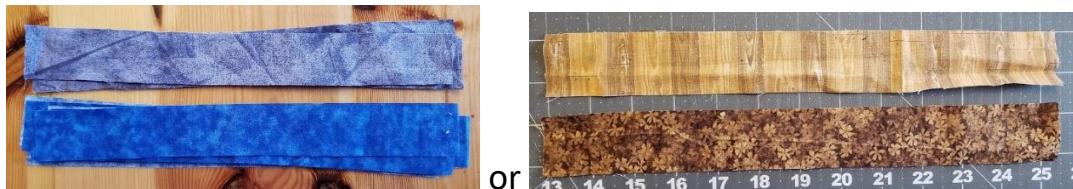
Blue/Gray and Red/Brown/Gold

**Do not make BOTH blue/gray and brown/red/gold unless you are making two quilts!**

### 1. First:

From your royal blues or medium browns, cut strips that are 1.5" x 12.5"



You need this many:

- Lap – 16
- Full – 48
- Queen – 64

Take those pieces and put them away in your zipper bags.

### 2. Second:

From your royal blues and darker grays OR your reds/browns/golds cut 3.5" squares like this:



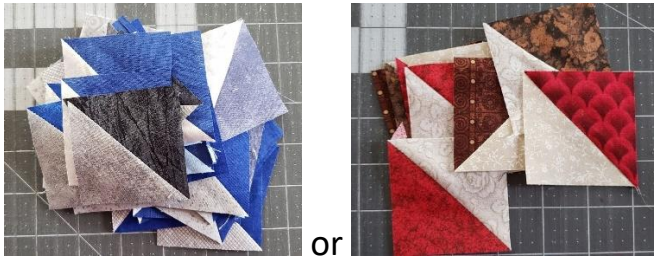
You need this many:

- Lap – 12 grays, 12 blues
- Full – 30 grays, 32 blues
- Queen – 40 grays, 40 blues

Take those pieces and put them away in your zipper bags.

### 3. Third:

Make half square triangles (HST) that will be 2.5" at this point – that look like this:



To make HST using the method I show, cut this many of darks/lights of the colorway you are using:

- Lap – 86 darks, 86 lights
- Full – 133 darks, 133 lights
- Queen – 144 darks, 144 lights

***Using the method shown below, make the HST. If you prefer another method, use it. It is fine. You need to end up with 2.5" HST.***

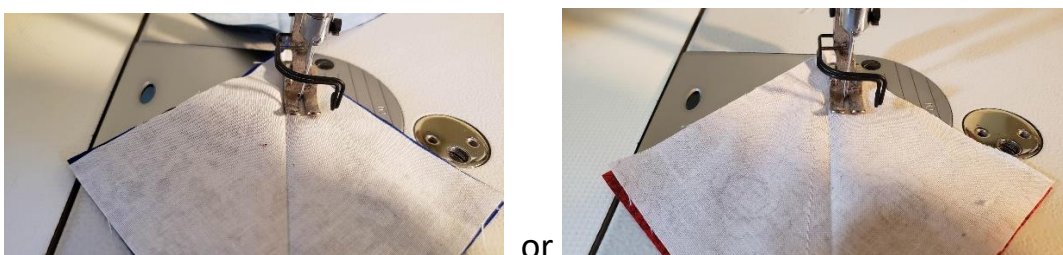
Fold the lights in half diagonally and iron on creased line.



Place light fabric on top of dark fabric, right sides together.



Sew ¼" on each side of the creased line.



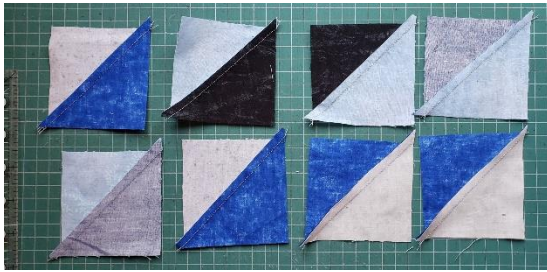
Cut apart.



Or



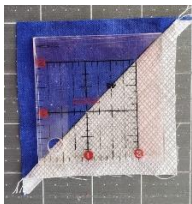
Press open. Press half of them with seam towards the lights, half towards the dark.



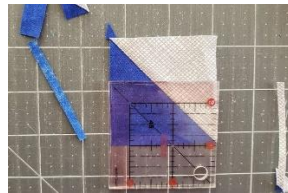

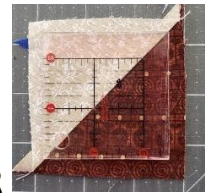
Trim to 2.5" using a 2.5" template.



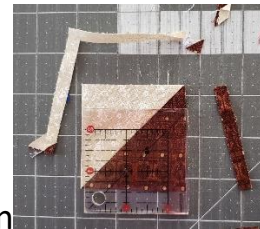

Place in your zipper bags, keeping them separate based on which direction the seams are pressed!

We want this many finished HST from today's piecing:

- Lap – 172 – with half pressed one direction, half pressed the other direction
- Full – 266 – with half pressed one direction, half pressed the other direction
- Queen – 288 – with half pressed one direction, half pressed the other direction

Then

Put all your finished pieces in those zipper bags and keep them safe! We will be using them!

And that's it for this time! Save all your scraps.

Put away your pieces for now and come back next week!
