## Radio Waves

To make the quilt pictured:


## You need:

- $65 / 8$ of cream/off white fabric for background
- $51 / 8$ yards of various fall colored fabrics
- $3 / 4$ yards for the binding (I cut into $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips and do a folded over binding)


## Cut:

## For main block:

From fall colored fabrics fabrics:

- 64-71/2"x $71 / 2$ " squares


## For sashings:

(Note: I did not strip piece these as I was using shirting pieces - thus my original fabrics were not long. I cut them individually as $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces of fabric.)

From off white/cream:

- 288-11/2" $\times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
- $288-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2 \prime$ strips

From fall colored fabrics:

- 432-11/2" $\times 31 / 2 \prime$ " strips

For cornerstones: (read description of how I made these in "how to make these blocks")
From off white/cream:

- $162-2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
- $162-2^{\prime \prime} \times 5.5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

From fall colored fabrics fabrics:

- 81-21/2"x $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares


## How to make the blocks:

## Main blocks:

Your main block is a plain piece of fabric - cut $71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$. Once they are cut, you are done! Wasn't that easy?
You need 64 for the quilt pictured above.

## Sashing sets:

Each sashing set finishes at $5.5^{\prime \prime} \times 7.5^{\prime \prime}$ It looks like this when finished:


Sew 2 cream colored $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to 3 fall colored $1 \frac{1}{2^{\prime \prime}} \times 3{ }^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ strips so that it looks like this:


Then add the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cream strips to the top and bottom of this unit.


Finished unit is $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Make 144.

## Cornerstone blocks:

Using your $2^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ colorful square, sew a cream colored $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2 \prime}$ rectangle to each side like this:


Then add your $2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{11 / 2}$ cream strip to the top and bottom. Finished block will look like this and should measure $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$


Make 81.

## How to make this quilt:

1. After making all the blocks as directed above, lay out your blocks as you wish, making sure the colors are what pleases you. I took a picture when placing them on the floor so that I could look at the colors and check to see that I liked it (I had randomly sewn one sashing strip to each side of a block before placing them on the floor to check for color placement of the main blocks.


Use this diagram to help you:


I sewed the main rows together first, placing a sashing strip between each block and then created rows of only sashing and cornertones and sewed them to the rows.
Main rows:


Rows with only sashing and cornerstones:

2. Press well.
3. Sandwich, using whatever type of batting and backing you prefer.
4. Quilt as desired.
5. Bind, using whatever method you wish.
