## Rails in Focus

$87 \times 97.5^{\prime \prime}$
To make the quilt pictured:


This quilt is made up of one $7.5^{\prime \prime}$ finished in the quilt block and it looks like this:
$\square$

## You need:

- 7/8 of a yard of scraps in the colors as shown - purple, pink, lighter pink, dark yellow, yellow
- $37 / 8$ yards of black


## Cut:

For blocks:

- From various colors as shown, a total of 360 strips, cut 2 " $\times 8$ ".

For sashing:
From black:

- 81 Strips - 3.5 "x8.6"
- 10 strips that are $3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 87.5^{\prime \prime}$ - piece to get the length needed

How to make the block: This is commonly called a 5-rail rail fence block.


Take your 2"x8" strips in the layout and order of colors that you wish and sew them together as shown. Make 72.

## How to put together this quilt:

1. Decide how you want the blocks in the quilt - lay out according to this layout, turning every other block 90 degrees:

2. Sew each row together and put a sashing strip on the sides of each block like this:


And

3. Now sew a row of black 3.5 " $\times 87.5^{\prime \prime}$ sashing between each row


Continue in same manner til the quilt top is the size you want. This one goes for 9 rows. Make sure to alternate directions of blocks. This layout is $8 \times 9$.
4. Press well.
5. Sandwich, using whatever type of batting and backing you prefer
6. Quilt as desired. I did a wavy line with contrasting thread with the walking foot.
7. Bind, using whatever method you wish.
