Simple Squares

To make the quilt pictured:



You need:

- 1 5/8 yards pink
- 3 3/8 yards of geometrics
- 5/8 yards of solid black
- ½ yard of fabric for the binding.
 This quilt is made up of simple squares which are cut 4.5".

<u>Cut:</u>

From various geometrics -

• Cut 77 – 4.5" squares

From pink –

• Cut 77 – 4.5" squares


Borders will be dealt with under "How to put together this quilt".

Construct Blocks:

This quilt uses a simple square – no piecing to the blocks.

How to make this quilt:

1. Alternate blocks so that they are in this layout: Focus only on the middle at this point.



1. Sew them in rows. Press towards the darker color.

Alternate the pink and geometrics.

- 2. Add the borders: (Piece as necessary to get the length needed)
 - A. First border: black
 - Cut 2 1.5"x 56.5" attach to sides
 - Cut 2 1.5"x 46.5" attach to top and bottom
 - B. Second border: geometrics
 - Cut 2 4.5"x 58.5" attach to sides
 - Cut 2 1.5"x 54.5" attach to top and bottom
- 3. Press well.
- 4. Sandwich, using whatever type of batting and backing you prefer
- 5. Quilt as desired. I did straight line quilting.
- 6. Bind, using whatever method you wish.

It's that easy!!!! Your quilt is finished!
