## Simple Squares

## 54"x66"

To make the quilt pictured:


## You need:

- 15/8 yards pink
- $33 / 8$ yards of geometrics
- $5 / 8$ yards of solid black
- $1 / 2$ yard of fabric for the binding.

This quilt is made up of simple squares which are cut 4.5".

## Cut:

From various geometrics -

- Cut $77-4.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares

From pink -

- Cut $77-4.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares

Borders will be dealt with under "How to put together this quilt".

## Construct Blocks:

This quilt uses a simple square - no piecing to the blocks.

## How to make this quilt:

1. Alternate blocks so that they are in this layout: Focus only on the middle at this point.

2. Sew them in rows. Press towards the darker color.

Alternate the pink and geometrics.
2. Add the borders: (Piece as necessary to get the length needed)
A. First border: - black

- Cut $2-1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 56.5^{\prime \prime}$ - attach to sides
- Cut 2-1.5" $46.5^{\prime \prime}$ - attach to top and bottom
B. Second border: geometrics
- Cut $2-4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 58.5^{\prime \prime}$ - attach to sides
- Cut $2-1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 54.5^{\prime \prime}$ - attach to top and bottom

3. Press well.
4. Sandwich, using whatever type of batting and backing you prefer
5. Quilt as desired. I did straight line quilting.
6. Bind, using whatever method you wish.

## It's that easy!!!! Your quilt is finished!
