## Sixteen in the Spotlight

Top finishes at $92^{\prime \prime} \times 108.5^{\prime \prime}$
To make the quilt pictured:


## You need:

- reds : 2 1/3 yards (for 16 patches, corners of frames, 4 patches and sashing)
- whites/cream: 5 1/2 yards (for 16 patches, cream strips, lights in the 4 patches, sashing, first border)
- bold colors such as blue, red, green: 30-2"x26" strips
- browns: $2 / 3$ yard of various scraps
- lighter browns/tans: 2/3 yard of various scraps
- $3 / 8$ yard each of 4 colors bold colors for border pieces
- $1 / 2-5 / 8$ yard of fabric for the binding. (I used scrappy $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ strips.)


## Cut:

- From various reds for 16 patches and corners of frames

600-2 \times 2^{\prime \prime} \text { squares }
$$

24-2^{\prime \prime \times 3.5 "} \text { rectangles (for sashing) }
$$

- From cream/whites:

$$
\begin{aligned}
& 480-2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime} \text { squares } \\
& 480-2^{\prime \prime \times} \times 3.5^{\prime \prime} \text { strips } \\
& 48-2^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime} \text { (for sashing) }
\end{aligned}
$$

- From browns: 120-2"x3.5" strips
- From lighter browns/tans:

120-2"x3.5" strips

- From bold colors such as blue, red, green

30 matching sets of $4-2^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$ strips

Construct Blocks: This quilt consists of only one block plus sashing.
Make all the segments:
16 patches: from red/white 2 " squares.


Make 30.

4 patches: From red and cream or white:


Sets of cream 2"x3.5" strips for center of blocks: They look like this: (You could use a $3.5^{\prime \prime}$ square here, but I used various creams as I was trying to use up my 2" strips.)


Make 240.

Sets of tan/brown 2"x3.5" strips:


Make 120.
Then, I built my blocks from the inside out:

1. Put frame around the 16 patch:

Sew a 2 "x $6.5^{\prime \prime}$ bold colored strip to the right side and one to the left.
Sew together one red square to a $2^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$ bold colored strip and then another $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ red square. Like this:


Attach to the top. Do the same on the bottom. It will now look like this:


At this point it should be $9.5^{\prime \prime} \times 9.5^{\prime \prime}$.
2. Sew the 3 strip sets together - cream, brown/tan, cream

3. Put the strips on the sides. It will now look like this:

5. Sew together the next set of blocks so that they look like this:


Sew to top and bottom of block so that the finished block looks like this:


It should measure 15.5"x15.6".
Make sashing pieces:
Sew a 2 "x6.5" cream strip to a 2 "x3.5" red strip, and then to another 2 " $\times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$ cream strip.


They will be 2 " $\times 15.5$ " long at this point:

## How to make this quilt:

1. Lay out completed blocks according to diagram. Make sure the frames are laid out so that the colors are pleasing to you.

## 2. Sew together in rows.

You will sew together, block, sashing, block, sashing strip, block, etc. until the layout is 5 blocks wide by 6 blocks tall.


## 3. Add borders:

- Inner border of cream:

Cut $2-2 " x 98 "$ pieces for sides. (You will need to piece this.)
Cut $2-2 " \times 84.5^{\prime \prime}$ pieces for top and bottom. (You will need to piece.)
Attach, putting on side pieces first.

- Outer border:

Cut from four colors:
Cut 2-4.5"x101" (Piece it.)
Cut 2-4.5" x 92.5" (Piece it.)
4. Press well.
5. Sandwich, using whatever type of batting and backing you prefer.
6. Quilt as desired.
7. Bind, using whatever method you wish.
