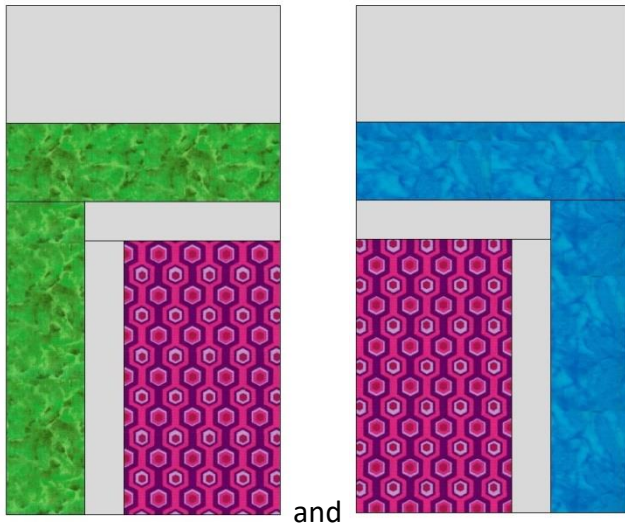
To make the quilt pictured:



You need:

- 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards of gray
- 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards of blue for border including a few parts of blocks
- 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards of novelty fabric – for the center of the blocks
- 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ yards (total) of other coordinating fabrics with the featured fabric
- $\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{5}{8}$ yard of fabric for the binding.

This quilt is made up of 2 main blocks which are similar but different:



This quilt is made up of 48 blocks – 24 of each block:

For this size of quilt: (queen size)

Cut:

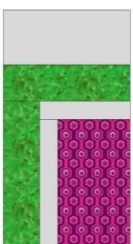
- From gray:
 $48 - 3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$
 $48 - 1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$
 $48 - 1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$
- From novelty fabric (center of this block):
 $48 - 4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$
- From various colors – cut in sets:
 One of these sets for each block:
 $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$
 $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$

Borders will be discussed later:

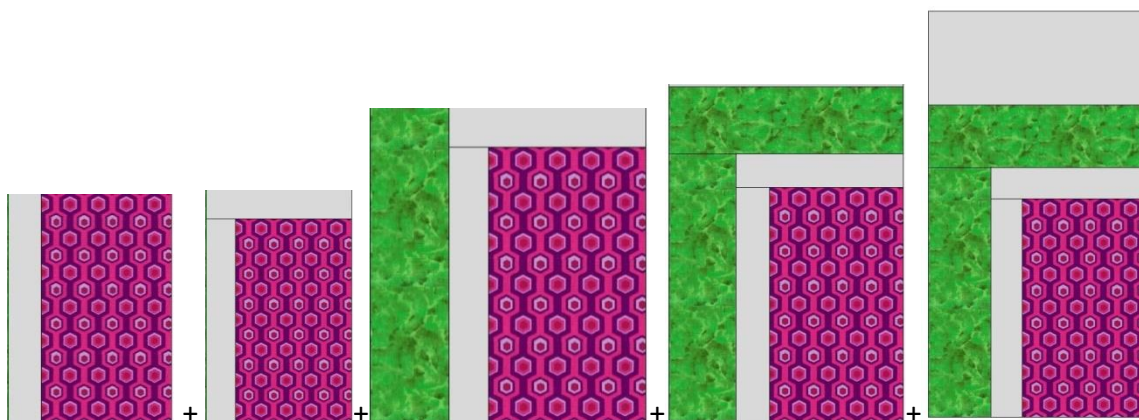
Construct blocks:

Make 24 of each block:

Block 1:

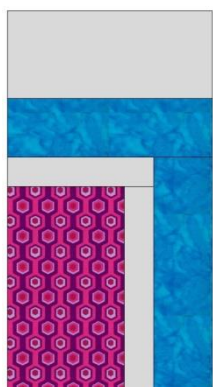


Start with your main center piece and add the pieces like this:

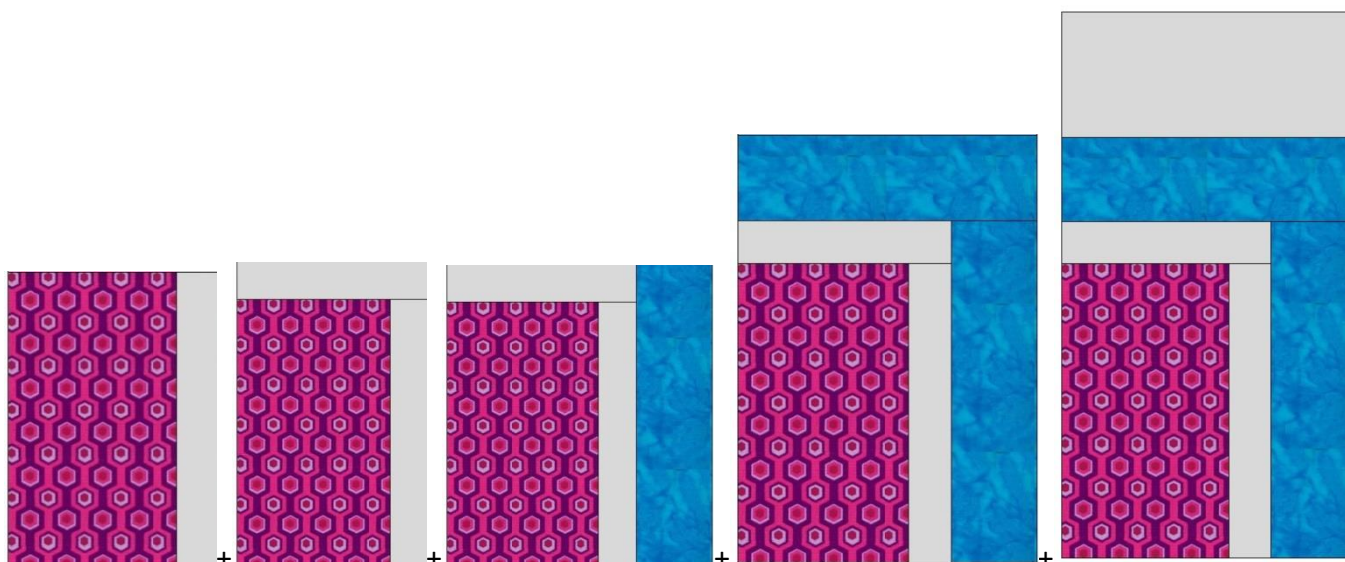


Make a variety instead of the green. I made a variety using several colors. Make a total of 24 blocks.

Block 2:

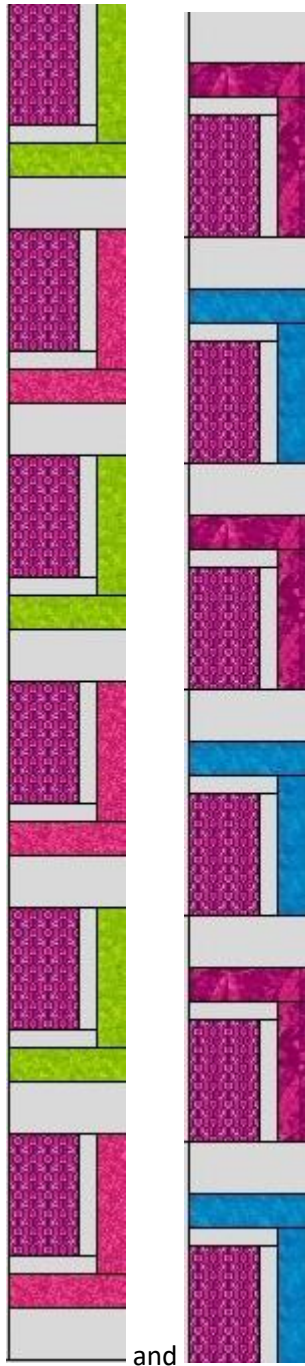


Start with your main center piece and add the pieces like this:

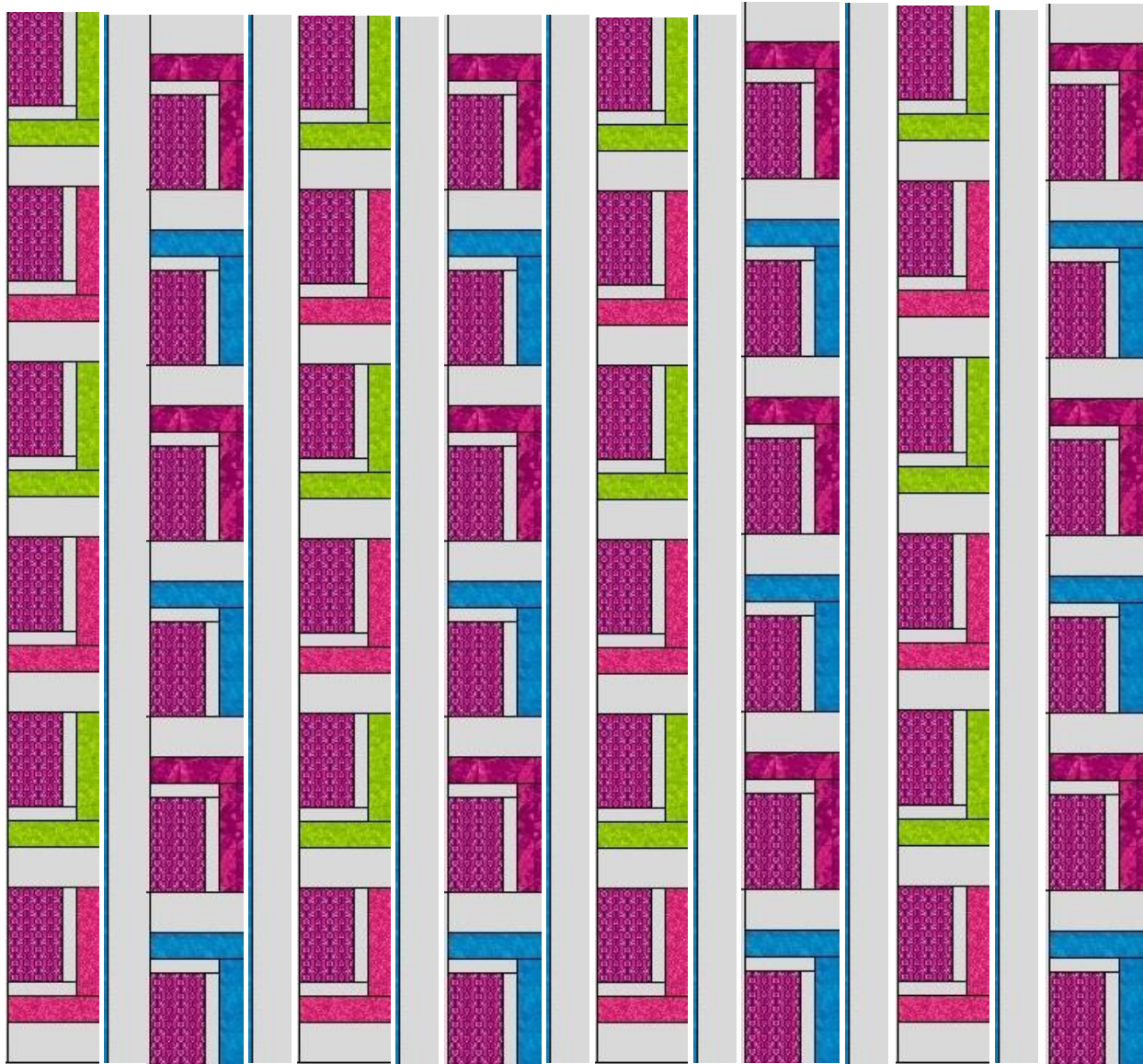


How to make this quilt:

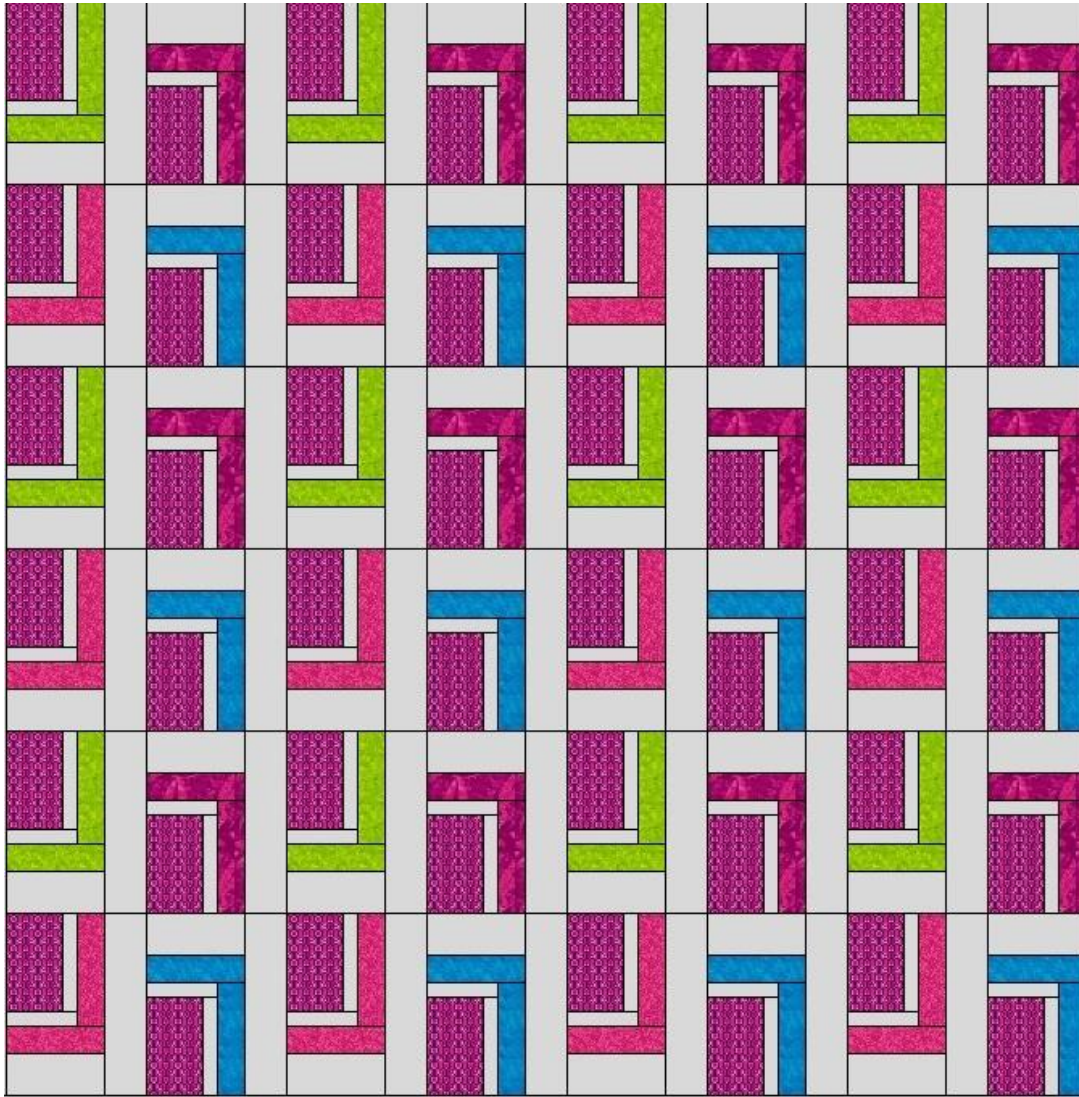
1. Construct your blocks as shown above. Make 24 of each layout.
2. Place blocks as in this diagram.
3. Make 4 rows of blocks that are 6 blocks long:



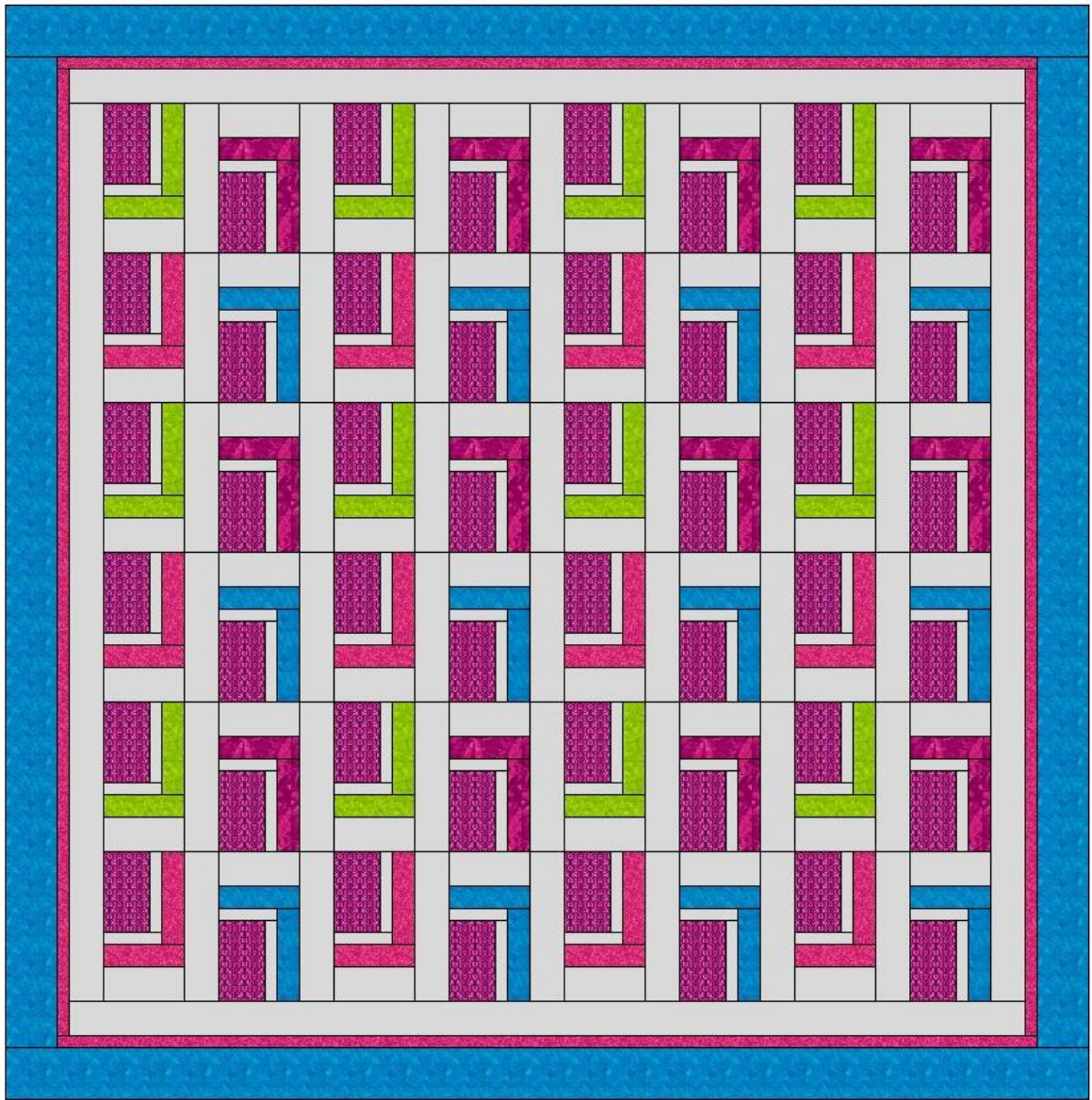
4. Add a strip of gray $3\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by the length and add to the right of these strips except for the last one



So that it looks like this:



5. **Sew these all together.** (I know that my middle gray strips look like they are pieced in this layout but they aren't in reality.) This makes a nice sized center.
 6. **Add the borders:**
 - **First border – gray border**
 Cut: (piece as necessary)
 2 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ "x $78\frac{1}{2}$ " . Attach to the sides
 2 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ "x $83\frac{1}{2}$ " . Attach to the top and bottom.
 - **Second border – hot pink in my quilt top pictured above**
 Cut: (piece as necessary)
 2 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $84\frac{1}{2}$ " . Attach to the sides
 2 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ "x $85\frac{1}{2}$ " . Attach to the top and bottom.
 - **Third border – blue (in my quilt top)**
 Cut: (piece as necessary)
 2 - 5"x $86\frac{1}{2}$ " . Attach to the sides
 2 - 5"x $94\frac{1}{2}$ " . Attach to the top and bottom.
- Final layout:



7. **Press well.**
8. **Sandwich**, using whatever type of batting and backing you prefer
9. **Quilt** as desired.
10. **Bind**, using whatever method you wish.

It's that easy!!!!
