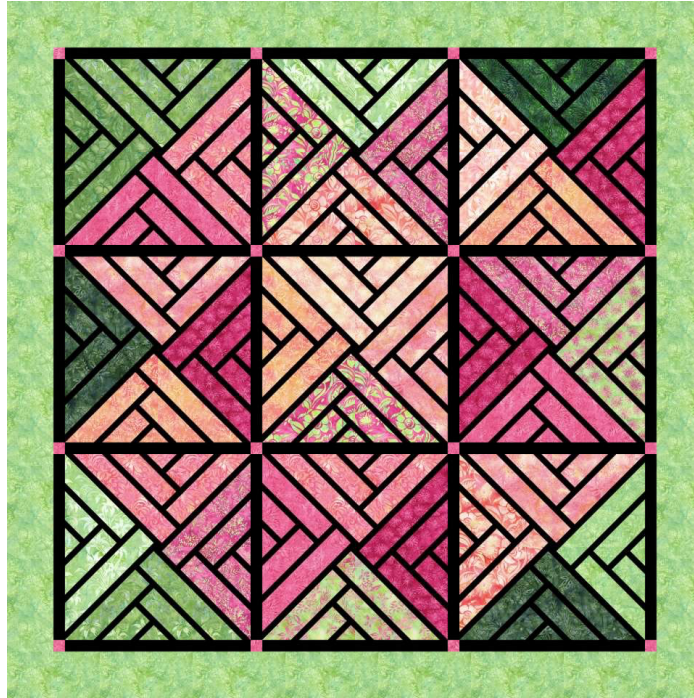


FRACTURED PAINT BOX



Book/Pattern Requirements:
Fractured Paint Box by Quiltworx
60" x 77"

Fabric Requirements:
(48) 2 ½" strips (there should be a range of light, medium light, medium, medium dark, dark)
1-¾ yards for the accent strips
1/8 yard for the cornerstones
2 yards for the border fabric
5/8 yard for binding
5 yards for the backing

Suggested Supplies and Tools:
Rotary Cutter and Mat
Ruler 6 ½" x 18"; I also like to use a 1-½" x 12-½" ruler for trimming.
Sewing machine in good working condition
Any attachment for your sewing machine which makes ¼" seams more precisely.
Neutral sewing thread (50 or 60 weight)

Seam Ripper
12" Add-A-Quarter Ruler
Clover Quilting Pins Fines - #2509
Scotch tape (non-glossy)
Scotch Repositionable Glue Stick (clear)
1 box of (12) Hefty Jumbo Storage Slider Bags (2.5 Gallons)
Purple Thang
70/10 Microtex sharp needles
Large/Jumbo paper clips
Sewline or Fons & Porter glue pen

If you would like to make your quilt larger, you would purchase the Fractured Paint Box replacement papers in addition to the pattern.

Pre-Class Homework:

- Read the instructions. Check on the Quiltworx website for any corrections and print the pages out.
- There are (8) sheets of foundation and template papers NP213 and (1) page of TP 364. Please cut your papers out, not on the bold line, but leaving 1/8" around each unit. Do NOT cut a part any templates. We will place the templates on top of the fabric strips, then cut the templates and fabrics a part.
- I will show you how to cut your strips using the templates provided during class.
- Fractured Paint Box is in Quiltster.

Fractured Paint Box is considered a beginner's pattern. It is a fun and very popular pattern to make. Feel free to choose an accent strip other than black, if you would like. I've seen accent strips in white, gray and even lime green!
