

POCKET COMPASS



Book/Pattern Requirements:

Pocket Compass by Quiltworx
40" x 40"

Fabric Requirements:

Please see the fabric chart on page 16 of the pattern or Quiltster for specific yardage amounts.

3/8 yard for binding

2-3/4 yards for the backing

Suggested Supplies and Tools:

Rotary Cutter and Mat

Ruler 6 1/2" x 18"; I also like to use a 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" ruler for trimming.

Sewing machine in good working condition

Any attachment for your sewing machine which makes 1/4" seams more precisely.

Neutral sewing thread (50 or 60 weight)

Seam Ripper

12" Add-A-Quarter Ruler

Clover Quilting Pins Fines - #2509

Scotch tape (non-glossy)
Scotch Repositionable Glue Stick (clear)
3 - Hefty Jumbo Storage Slider Bags (2.5 Gallons)
Purple Thang
70/10 Microtex sharp needles
Large/Jumbo paper clips
Sewline or Fons & Porter glue pen
Sharpie marker or other permanent marker for writing on the 3 Hefty bags

Pre-Class Homework:

- Read the instructions. Check on the Quiltworx website for any corrections and print the pages out. I like to put my patterns in a small binder with sheet protectors.
- I will show you how to cut out your fabrics and papers at the first class. It would be helpful for you to know what fabric you are using and in what sections. There are fabric swatch charts on pages 6, 9 and 12, where you can paste small pieces of fabric in the appropriate sections; these charts also correspond with Quiltster printouts.
- Pocket Compass is in Quiltster. Most manufacturers, designers and fabric lines are available in the program. You can also upload your fabric scans and photos. Quiltster will give you a detailed list of how much fabric you will need.

Pocket Compass is considered a beginner's pattern. It is a fun and a newer pattern to make.
