Book/Pattern Requirements:

Prismatic Star by Quiltworx
68" x 68"

Fabric Requirements:

(48) 2 1/2" strips
1-1/4 yards for sashing fabric
2-3/8 yards for background fabric
4-4 yards for backing
5/8 yards for binding

Tools Required:

Rotary Cutter and Mat
Ruler – bring a larger ruler for cutting yardage and a smaller one for trimming blocks.
(Personally, I love the Creative Grids 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" ruler for trimming.)
Sewing machine in good working condition
Any attachment for your sewing machine which makes 1/4" seams more precisely.
Neutral cotton sewing thread of a good quality (50 weight)
Seam Ripper
12" Add-A-Quarter Ruler
Scotch tape (non-glossy)
8 Large Ziploc bags
Purple Thang
70/10 Microtex sharp needles
Jumbo paper clips
UHU or Elmer's washable glue stick
Sewline or Fons & Porter glue pen
Clover Quilting Pins Fine

Pre-Class Homework:

- Please read the instructions. I like to put my instructions in a binder, using plastic page inserts. I trim just a sliver off of the fold edge of my instructions and then put each sheet into a plastic page insert. Please go to www.quiltworx.com to check for any corrections to the pattern.
- Please see the attached chart that you will use to coordinate your color groups.
- There are 24 stars/diamonds, each one containing 16 “smaller diamonds.”
- Please cut your papers out, **not on the bold line**, but leaving 1/8” around each unit. **Do not cut the paper units into individual strips**; after you have sewn the fabric onto the units, then you will cut them into strips. I will show you how to do this in class.
- Try **QUILTSTER**. On Quiltster, you can design your own Prismatic Star. You can submit your own fabric choices or use fabric lines already entered into Quiltster. When you have completed your design, you can print out a picture and the yardage amounts that you will need.
- Please have your (48) strips ready and your papers cut out for class. We will cut out you’re sashing and background fabric in class.
- This class is for the 68” x 68” Prismatic Star pattern. If you decide to make a larger Prismatic Star, I will try my best to help you with that portion as well, but I cannot guarantee that there will be enough time for me to do so. I am always available to assist you with this part at the next Quiltworx UFO class (November 7, 2026 at Quilted Ewe).
