## PLEASE READ ALL THE INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE YOU BEGIN.

*All seems are sewn with a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.

* PLEASE OPEN ALL SEAMS to assist with bulk.

Fabrics Required:
5/8 yd dark fabric (A)

$1 / 3$ yd medium fabric (C)
$1 / 4$ yd medium fabric (D)
$1 / 3$ yd medium light fabric (E)
$11 / 3$ yd light fabric (F) $1 / 4$ yd inner border fabric $11 / 4$ yd outer border fabric 5/8 yd binding fabric $31 / 2$ yd backing fabric (piece horizontally)

## Cutting Instructions:

From the dark fabric (A) cut:
Four 2 7/8" strips; subcut into forty $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares cut diagonally once Three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips; subcut into forty 2 1/2" squares
From the medium dark fabric ( $B$ ) cut:
Five $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strips; subcut into sixty $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares cut diagonally once
One 3 1/4" strip; subcut into ten $31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares cut diagonally twice
From the medium fabric ( $C$ ) cut:
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Four 2 1/2" strips; subcut into fifty $2 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares
From the medium fabric (D) cut: $\quad$ \#\#\#
Three $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips; subcut into forty $2 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares
From the medium light fabric (E) cut: 《>>>


One $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip; subcut into ten $2 \frac{1^{\prime \prime}}{2}$ squares
Two $31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips; subcut into twenty $31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares cut diagonally twice
From the light fabric (F) cut:
Eight $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips; subcut into (120) $2 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Seven $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strips; subcut into (100) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares cut diagonally once
One 3 1/4" strip; subcut into ten $31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares cut diagonally twice

the inner border fabric cut:
Five $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips; piece together and subcut into two $1 \frac{1^{\prime \prime}}{} \times 50 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ borders and two $1 \frac{1^{\prime \prime}}{} \times 42 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ borders From the outer border fabric cut:

Six $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips; piece together and subcut into two $6 \frac{1^{\prime \prime}}{} \times 52 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ borders and two $6 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 54 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ borders From the binding fabric cut:

Seven 2 1/2" strips; piece together to make one long strip

## Assembly:

1. Sew the dark and light $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ triangles together as shown. Make 80.
 Sew the medium dark and light $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ triangles together. Make 120.
2. Sew two medium light, one light, and one medium dark $3 \frac{1}{4}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ triangles together as shown. Make 40.

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3. Sew the blocks together as shown. Make 10 EACH BLOCK.

4. Sew the quilt top together in five rows of four alternating blocks.
5. Sew the $1 \frac{1^{\prime \prime}}{} \times 50 \frac{1^{\prime \prime}}{}$ inner borders to the two sides of the quilt top. Sew the $1 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 42 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ inner borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Sew the $6 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 52 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ outer borders to the two sides of the quilt top. Sew the $6 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 54 \frac{1}{2}$ " outer borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
6. Layer the quilt back right side down, the batting, and the quilt top. Quilt as desired. Trim the backing and batting even with the quilt top.
7. Stitch the binding, raw edges even to the quilt. Turn to the back and slipstitch.
