

Row by Row Easy Tote Bag

Honey Bee Quilt Store 2015

1. Make the row according to the directions, but be sure to cut the longhorn out as close to the top of the black fabric as possible so you have plenty of extra fabric hanging down below the grass/ edge of the gray fabric when you applique it.
2. Layer the bag lining (right side down), soft & stable, & row (right side up). Pin & quilt as desired.



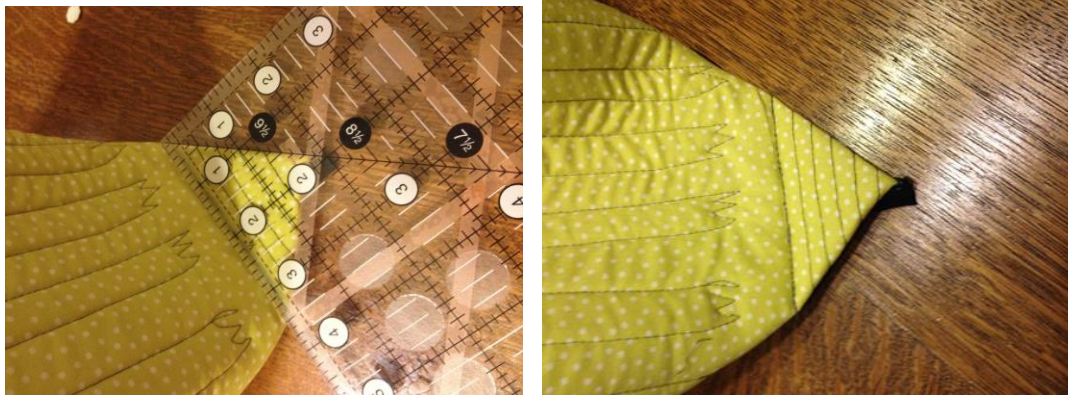
3. Trim to approximately 12 1/2" x 38"
4. Fold in half & sew the bottom and side.



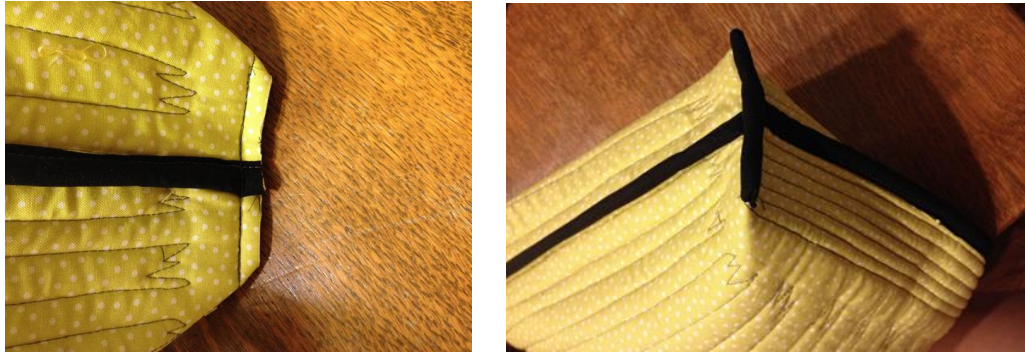
5. Bind the bottom and side (just like a quilt). Leave the unfinished ends, they will get trimmed later



6. Box pleat the bottom to corners to make a 3 1/2" bag bottom.



7. Trim the corners to 1/4" seam allowance & bind. Tuck in the unfinished ends when you pull the binding around.



8. Bind the top edge of the bag (just like a quilt)



9. Sew on straps
