



Instructions by Debbie Balagia

**Supplies:**

- 1/3 yard of focus fabric (center front)
- 1/2 yard of coordinating fabric (backing and faux border)
- optional: ric-rac, yo-yos, etc

**Directions:**

1. Straighten cut edge of each fabric piece. Put right sides together.
2. Sew along long edges using 1/4" seams. Your fabric is now a tube. Turn it right side out.
3. Press edges to allow equal amounts of border to show on both sides of the focus fabric (this is the top of your table runner).
4. Top stitch the length of the seam on both sides of the borders you created.
5. Fold short end of the runner in half with the focus fabric *on the inside* and sew across.
6. Clip the inside corner and turn right side out creating the point of the table runner.
7. Baste your folded edge down the back side.

Your table runner is now complete! You can embellish it by adding ric-rac, yo-yos or any other trims. Add them between the two fabrics in step 1 or top stitch them in place in step 4!
