TUESDAY, AUGUST 9, 2022

AM Departures via motor coach from LaValle, Reedsburg, Baraboo, Sauk City, Lodi, Madison & Rockford. PM Depart from Chicago O'Hare Airport (SPECIFIC FLIGHT DETAILS WILL BE AVIALABLE IN SPRING 2022.)

Make own arrangements for flight to Fairbanks, Alaska. Meet the group at the Fairbanks hotel.
