We are hosting our 2nd Annual Airing of the Quilts on Friday, March 27th - more details to be announced later.

Many of you know of our Angel Fabric program -- we purchase estates and offer the items and fabric in the shop at a very discounted rate and use some of the proceeds to support our relief quilts we donate after storms, i.e., backing, fabric for piecing, quilting fees, shipping costs, etc. We shipped 55 quilts to Jamaica in December and to date we've donated a total of 200 quilts to those affected by storms.

That being said, I received a call just before the holidays that can only be called a true blessing!! The shop has purchased a private estate of quilting fabric, notions, and "stuff". We are in the beginning stages of processing the very large STASH and look forward to having in the shop as we go along. Our Angel Fabric shelves are full again and we will be offering other items throughout the store at discounted prices to help keep quilting affordable to everyone.

Add a splash of color with decorative thread or fabric scraps for a truly personalized piece. You'll leave with a finished bowl and the skills to create many more.

The first session, we will create a round bowl of your choice. It can be straight rope, you can add fabric in the bottom for a base or you can add fabric strips randomly or cover the entire bowl with fabric. The second class, we'll make an oval bowl with handles. Again, you can decorate the bowl in any number of ways.


